**O.P.P. Weekly Report**  
 During the week of April 27 to May 3 inclusive, officers of the Ontario Provincial Police attached to North Halton Detachment worked a total of 960 1/4 hours and patrolled 9,615 miles of area roads under their jurisdiction. Charges were laid against 62 motorists for a variety of driving offences, and an additional 45 were given warnings for minor driving errors or faulty equipment on their vehicles. Safety checks were performed on 28 vehicles. Convictions were registered against 96 persons in Provincial Judge's Court.  
 General occurrences requiring investigation this week number were 2 thefts, 1 disturbance, 2 threatening complaints, 2 wilful damage investigations, 1 investigation of a dog being shot led to 1 person being charged with 'wounding an animal', 1 stolen car was recovered for another police dept., 2 complaints of dogs running at large and 2 Liquor Control Act investigations led to charges being laid against 5 persons. All other occurrences were of a minor nature, requiring little time to clear.  
 During the 7 day reporting period, 18 accidents were investigated. Of this number 7 resulted in injuries to 11 persons. Predominant cause of the accidents was 'carelessness', and investigation resulted in 6 persons being charged with 'careless driving'. Other causes were: following too closely, failing to yield right of way, and fail to share half the road. Total property damage \$11,245.  
 In view of the large number of accidents caused by careless driving, Prov. Const. T. R. Penrice urges drivers to remember 3 C's of driving. Please use more Care, Courtesy and Common Sense when operating your motor vehicle.
