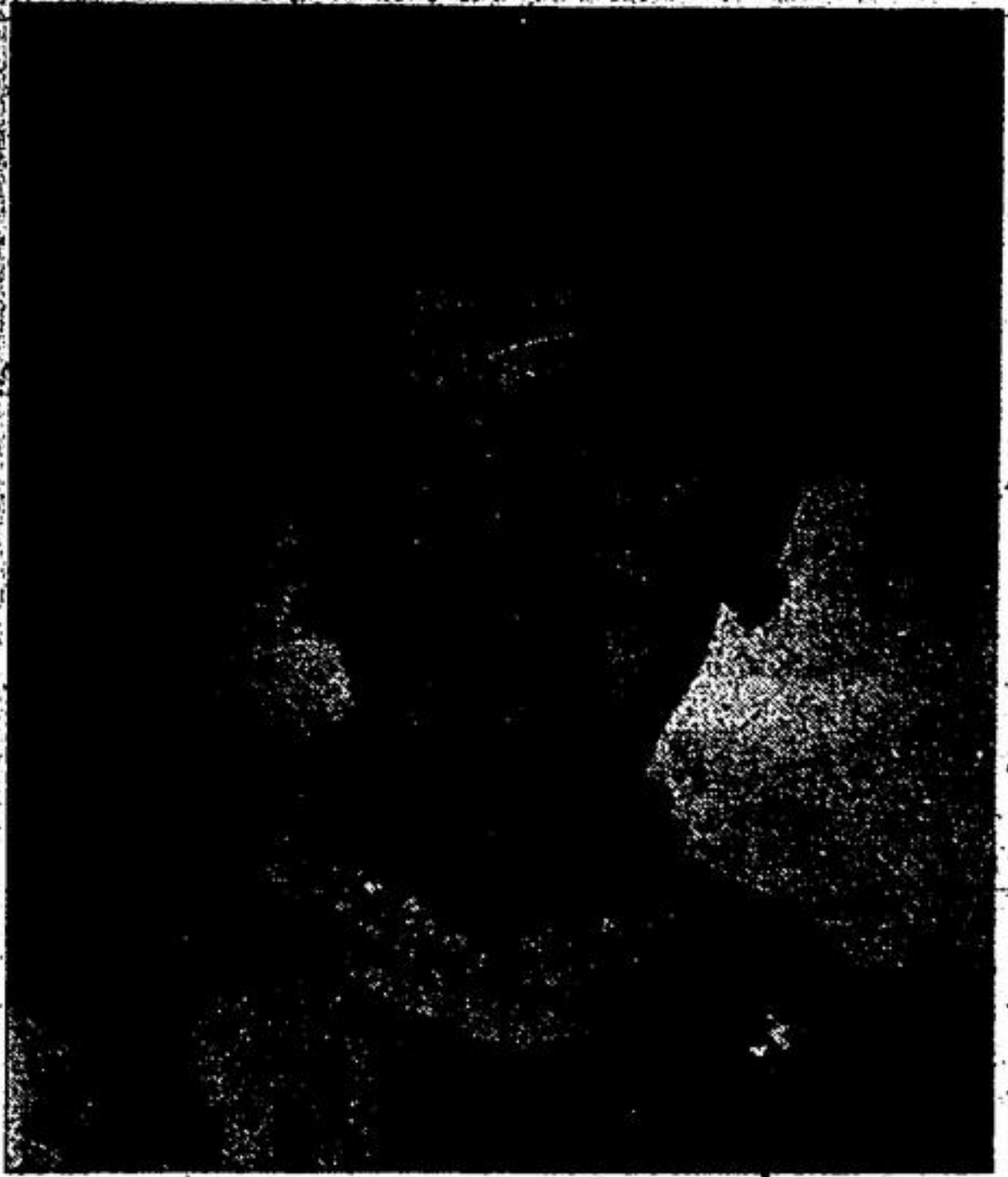


Park School Teacher Mrs. W. Cromar Retires

Was Honoured for Service With St. John Ambulance

Service for David Raymond Peason was conducted in the chapel of the Leo Archdekin Funeral Home, Brampton, Thursday, July 3, by Rev. Walter Ridley. Service was followed by interment in Hillcrest Cemetery, Norval.

Mr. Peason of R. R. 4 Georgetown, died Sunday, June 29 at the Princess Margaret Hospital, Toronto. He had been ill for the past two years. He was 42.

The son of Mrs. Mildred Peason, of Georgetown, and the late Frank Peason, he was born in Brampton, Nov. 28, 1926. He grew up in Brampton and Georgetown, and attended Georgetown High School.

He married Dorothy Sawyer of Brampton in 1947. The couple lived in Brampton and Huttonville, before moving to their present home in August of 1965. They have three children, Douglas 20, Lynn 14, and Karen 12.

Mr. Peason had been an em-

ployee of the Bell Telephone Company for the past 20 years, and until last year when he was forced to give up work because of poor health, he had worked at the Bell's engineering department in Brampton.

Mr. Peason was a hard-working member of the Brampton Lions Club, and a member of the committee instrumental in forming the St. John Ambulance Brigade in Brampton.

For the past 15 years he had been an instructor for the Order of St. John, and in 1963, when the ambulance brigade was formed, he became divisional officer. The same year, in reward for his outstanding services he was invested by Gov.-Gen. Georges Vanier in Ottawa as a serving Brother of the Order of St. John.

Mr. Peason was affiliated with Home Church on No. 17 Sideroad. He leaves two sisters, Mrs. James (Betty) Dear of Florida and Mrs. K. (Kay) Rundle of Lakeside, and brothers Wilf and George of Milton and Bill of Georgetown.

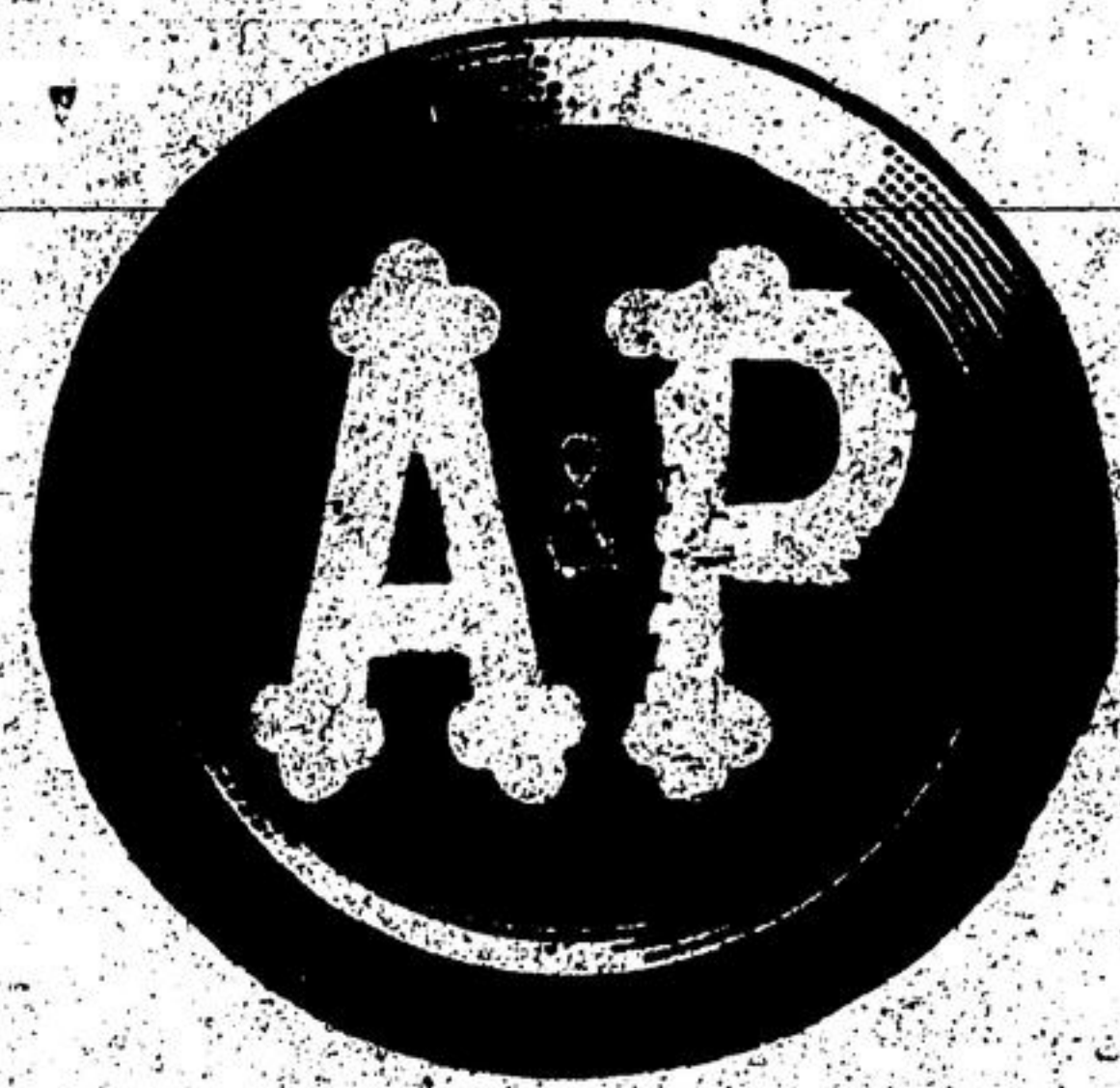

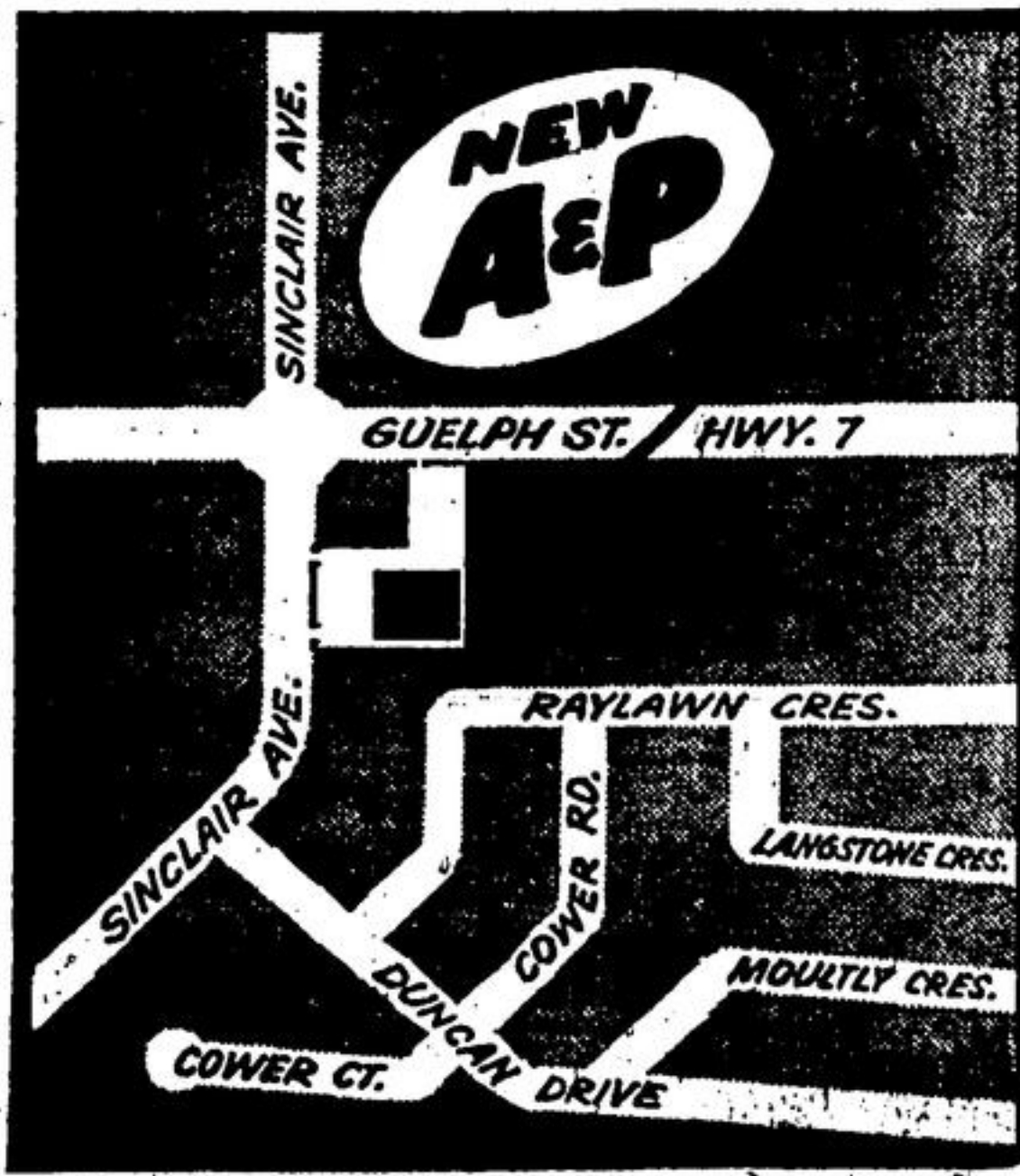
