Wild Limehouse Chase

A 20 year old driver who sped through Limehouse at 75 miles per hour almost knocking down a man and a small child and forcing another car off the road was sentenced in county court last week to seven days' hard labour, fined \$300 and lost his license to drive for one year.

When he was sentenced, his young wife broke into tears and was led sobbing from the courtroom followed by the young man's lawyer, a grim faced Jack Bellegem of Georgetown.

During his wild, high-speed ride March 27, the Rockwood resident was pursued by Ontario Provincial Police constable Jim Hodson who chased him for more than seven miles before stopping him outside Acton.

The pursued car travelled at speeds of more than 95 miles per hour, swerved from shoulder to shoulder and went through a stop sign at one point, the officer told Judge Kenneth M. Langdon.

On the stand, the accused said he did not see the officer's roof light on during the chase and thought the car behind him contained some youths he had had trouble with in Georgetown.

He admitted to Crown Attorney Douglas Latimer of dragging down a street in Georgetown before the chase. He admitted drag racing another car two abreast at 60 miles per hour through a 30 mph zone.

Constable Hodson said he was driving a marked black and white OPP cruiser and put the roof light on at the beginning of the chase.

The officer told the court that the accused, after speeding through Limehouse, did

not stop at the stop sign at Highway 7, and continued on that highway at 95 miles per hour. Constable Hodson radioed Acton OPP to set up a road block but stopped the fleeing car just short of the roadblock.

Judge Langdon refused to accept defence counsel Bellegem's plea that his client feared he was in danger of bodily harm from the person he believed was in the pursuing car.

The judge called it a blatant case of dangerous driving and came down heavily on the defendant who was sent to county jail with hard labour plus another month if he cannot raise the \$300 fine.

Double Intermert Here For Pritchett Family

A double interment took place in the family plot in Greenwood Cemetery for Mrs. Pritchett and Mrs. Sutton.
