

## Erect Lights At Junction

BRAMPTON — The town engineer of Brampton has received permission from the Ontario department of highways to erect traffic lights at the corner of Steeles Ave. and Mississauga Rd. Reeva Nence Horwood of Brampton, told Peel County council yesterday.

Two prominent Brampton businessmen, Jack Carroll, former assistant deputy minister of the Ontario department of agriculture, and Harry Laughlin, both of Haldon and Peel Trust Company, died in an auto accident at the intersection Oct. 16.

## Receive Report From Minister

BRAMPTON — The town planning board last night received a report from Minister of Municipal Affairs Darcy McKeough, concerning aircraft noise at Toronto International Airport, as it affects municipalities and planning.

Included in the report were tables showing how specific municipalities are affected by the airport and a map illustrating zones which are now limited by the province as regards development.

Brampton, says the report, is relatively free from trouble from the airport, although part of industrial Bramalea lies within restricted zones.

## Complete Pickerel Check-Up

A department of lands and forests netting crew has completed a summer yellow pickerel study in the Moon River mouth area of Georgian Bay. They operated 11 eight-foot trap nets throughout August, scattered from the Moon River Basin to Clear Bay in the north and to Loon Portage in the west.

Netting was carried out to ascertain the distribution and movements of pickerel tagged in the Moon River last spring. In the past two years more than 8,000 of this species have been tagged in the area while only 58 were recaptured during the summer. It appears that many of the fish which spawn in the Moon are spread quite widely throughout the Bay during the warmer months of the year.

## Celebrate Anniversary

HUTTONVILLE — Rev. R. A. Steed, B.A., D.D., minister of Humber Valley United Church in Islington, and president of the Toronto Conference of United Churches, was guest speaker at the 11 a.m. service at Meadowvale United Church on Sunday, Oct. 18.

The occasion was the 106th anniversary of the church. Built in 1863, Meadowvale United Church was the Methodist Church until 1925 when the union of the two churches changed its name.

Rev. J. C. Johnson of Huttonville United Church officiated at the anniversary service, with Mrs. James Beatty of Streetsville as soloist and Mrs. Wilfred Penrose as organist.

## Tagged Fish Swam 50 Miles

A yellow pickerel tagging program undertaken last spring by the Quinte-Lake Ontario Fisheries Management Unit in Napanee is beginning to produce some interesting results. The tagging was conducted by unit staff in several of the rivers emptying into the east end of Concession Lake.

The program, on the major spawning grounds in the rivers and creeks connecting the Bay of Quinte and Lake Ontario, was undertaken to gain information on the movements of pickerel, to determine where these fish go when they leave their spawning grounds, and whether or not they have a homing instinct (return to the same streams year after year to spawn).

The wandering nature of some of the tagged fish is well demonstrated by a recapture and tag return from Mrs. R. H. Price of Johnson City, N.Y. who caught one of the tagged pickerel in the St. Lawrence River near Cape Vincent, N.Y. on July 18, 1969, that weighed 9 pounds 2 ounces.

The fish was tagged in the Napanee River on April 15, 1969, and after release had travelled a distance of more than 50 miles.

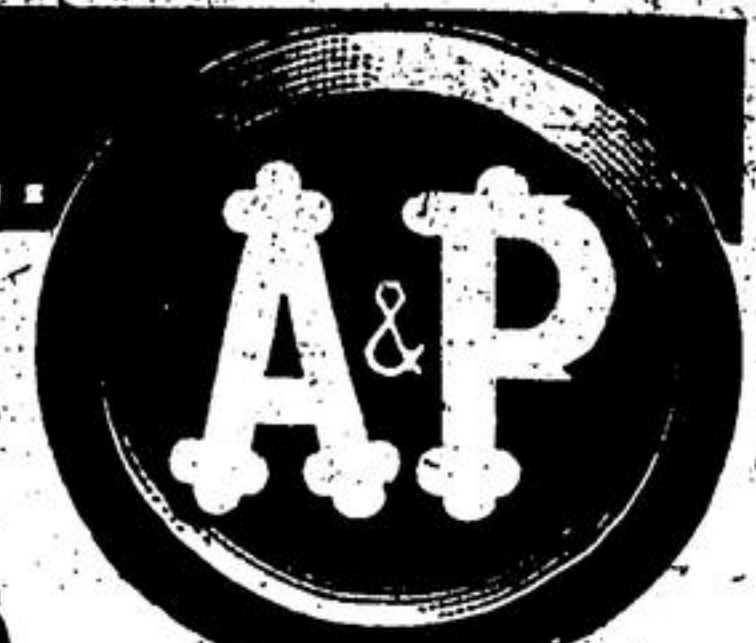
