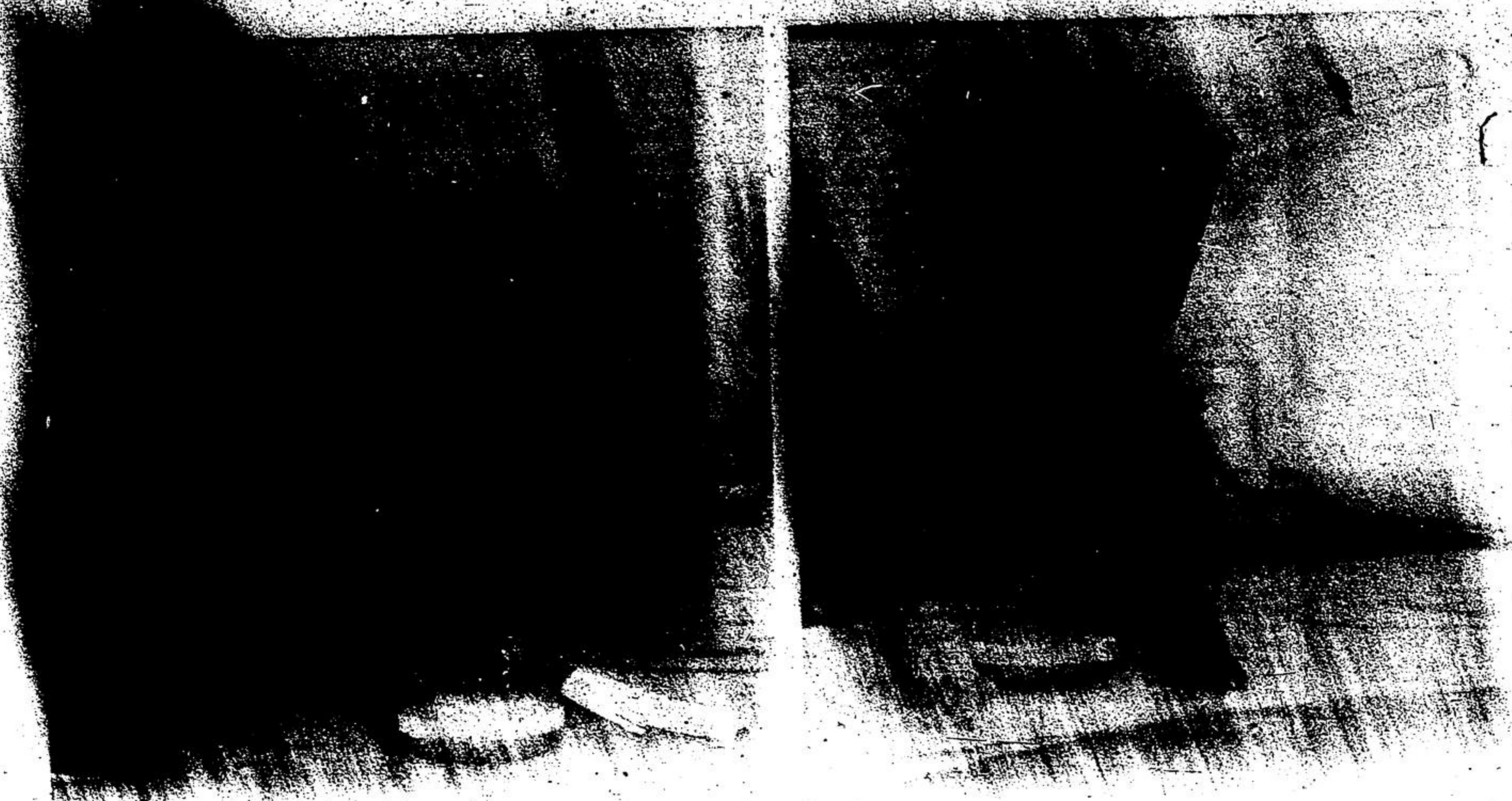
Juveniles Stretch Record With Another Win
