5. Professional Development Halton Division, O.S.S.T.F. asks for an increase from 1'4 to 1/2 of 1% of the Instructional Salary budget for professional development or an increase of. ..... 25,000.00

6. Teacher - Secretarial Ratio Halton Division, O.S.S.T.F. states that the existing secretarial ratio does not work and that the size of the secretarial staff should be established by the principal in consultation

with his staff. If one secretary were added to each secondary school, the increased cost 7. Summer and Night School Allowance

Halton Division, O.S.S.T.F. asks for a payment of \$12 per hour for teaching night school
