One fatality over holiday

One traffic fatality marred the last "Bring 'Em Back Alive" holiday weekend of the summer in the four counties served by the Hamilton Automobile Club (Halton, Haldimand, Brant and Wentworth). Brant County O.P.P. reported it as a single car accident, killing the driver on Ayl Road in Brant County.

The Hamilton Automobile Club reports there were 114 major accidents compared to 108 last year over the same three day holiday weekend from Friday midnight to midnight Monday.

Injuries totalled 68 — a considerable drop compared to last year's total of 91. Minor accidents were up only slightly with 49 compared to 46 in 1969.
