Proposes to Amend the Official Plan of the Acton Planning Area as provided for by Section 10 and Section 14 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1960

The Proposed Amendment is Cited Below:

Amendment No. 5 to the Official Plan of the Acton Planning Area.

(1) Purpose of Amendment  
The owner of the parcel of land covered by this amendment has requested an amendment to permit the development of commercial facilities which are not permitted within the Commercial-Highway designation.

(2) Description and Location  
A change in land use designation from "Commercial-Highway" to "Commercial-Neighbourhood" for a parcel of land located at the south corner of the intersection of Queen Street (Highway No. 7) and Churchill Road entitled, "Amendment No. 5 to the Official Plan of the Acton Planning Area."

(3) Text and Map Changes  
The following new section is to be added after Section B2 Commercial-General on page 9 of the Official Plan as follows:

**Commercial - Neighbourhood**  
"Commercial - Neighbourhood" shall mean that in the areas so designated by a symbol on Map Schedule I the predominant uses be small retail and service shops, such as grocery, confectionery, drug store, barber shop, and similar minor commercial uses which provide for the day-to-day needs of the immediate surrounding residential area. Included also are dwelling units in the form of apartments in the upper storeys over Commercial-Neighbourhood establishments.

This Designation does not imply that all new neighbourhood commercial facilities in residential areas will require an amendment to this Plan. The de-

velopment of new Commercial-Neighbourhood sites may be based on agreements relating to the approval of a plan of subdivision or by an appropriate amendment in the Zoning By-law subject to the policies for the establishment of neighbourhood commercial facilities as follows:

Commercial - Neighbourhood establishments should be concentrated in small groups of stores or as a small neighbourhood shopping area, to be located on a major street in order to provide easy access from all sections of the neighbourhood. Each area should contain enough off-street parking to prevent customers' cars from interfering with traffic.

Commercial - Neighbourhood sites are to be provided on the basis of approximately one acre of commercial land per 1,000 population served in the neighbourhood and should generally not exceed 1 or 2 acres in land area.

Where commercial and residential areas border on each other, adequate buffering should be provided in the form of a landscaped strip of land. Lighting of the off-street parking area should be so arranged to minimize nuisance to any surrounding dwellings.

Vehicle access points to and from a Commercial - Neighbourhood site shall be limited in number and clearly marked to minimize dangers to road and pedestrian traffic."

(4) Basis of the Amendment  
The Acton Official Plan does not contain policies regarding the development of neighbourhood shopping facilities. Due to several recent applications received by the Town for rezoning for the purpose of commercial development, it is considered desirable to amend the Official Plan to include statement and policies regarding the development of local or neighbourhood shopping facilities.

(5) Implementation  
By-law No. 70-1478 of the Town of Acton, which proposed to amend By-law No. 1358 to permit the development of five small retail outlets, will be repealed and re-adopted subject to the approval of the amendment.

Any persons interested may within the prescribed time, file in writing their opposition to or support of the said amendment, to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Acton Planning Board, 40 Mill Street East, Acton.

Final date for filing objections will be August 4, 1970.
