Commercial · Neighbourhood establishments should be concentrated in small groups of 17a50-tf stores or as a small neighbourhood shopping area, to be located on a major street in order to provide easy access from all sections of the neighbourhood. Each area should contain enough off-street parking to prevent customers' cars from in-

Commercial · Neighbourhood sites are to be provided on the basis of approximately one acre of commercial land per 1,000 population served in the neighbourhood and should generally not exceed 1 or 2 acres in land area.

Where commercial and residential areas border on each other, adequate buffering should be provided in the form of a landscaped strip of land. Lighting of

the off-street parking area should be so arranged to minimize mulsance to any surrounding dwellings.

Vehicular access points to and from a Commercial - Neighbourhood site shall be limited in number and clearly marked to minimize dangers to road and pedestrian traffic."

(4) Basis of the Amendment The Acton Official Plan does not contain policies regarding the development of neighbourhood shopping facilities.
