1. The Council of the Corporation of the Town of Acton intends to apply to the Ontario Municipal Board for approval of the reconstruction of Mill Street, from Park Avenue to Victoria Avenue, in order to improve the roadway and intersection to acceptable standards. The following works are required:
Excavation to new subgrade
Place granular basecourse
Extend existing storm sewer
Remove existing stone retaining wall and construct new wall
Construct asphalt pavement
Soil disturbed areas

The length of the proposed works is 450 feet at an estimated cost of \$31,550.00, whereof the amount of \$15,775.00 shall be raised by the sale of Debentures payable out of the general rate over a period not exceeding ten years.

2. Application will be made to the Ontario Municipal Board for an order to dispense with the assent of the electors to the undertaking of the said works.
