Snowmobilers must now report any collision on or off the highway which involves personal injury or damage exceeding \$200 to property other than that of the owner or driver.

The driver of a snowmobile

must hold a driver's licence to take his machine on a highway where snowmobile operation is permitted.

The owner of a snowmobile is to be held responsible for any infraction committed by persons using his machine.

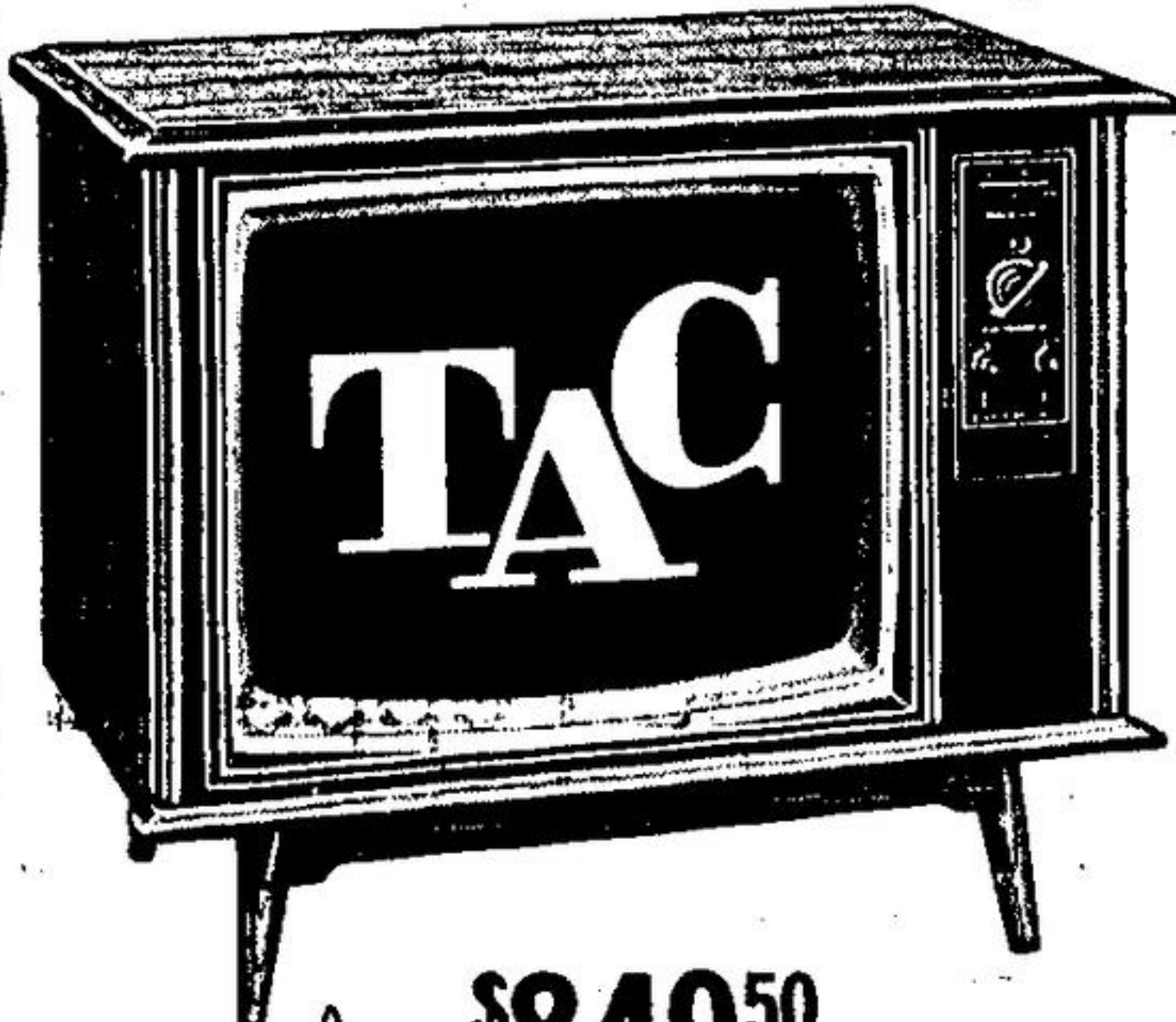

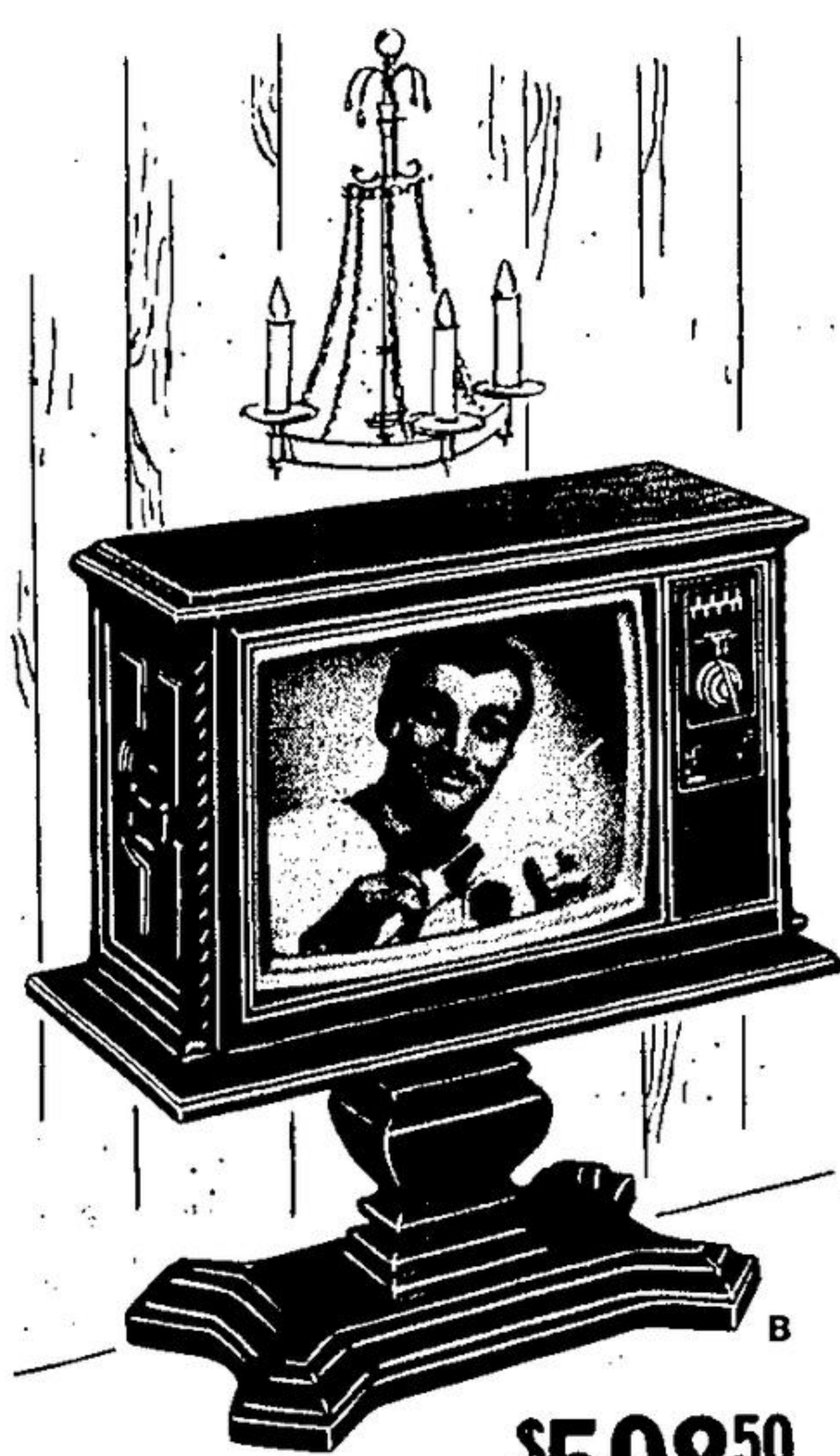

\$50 cheques for elderly

Elderly people—230,000 of them in the province—will benefit from the provincial government's \$50 special assistance plan.

Fifty dollar cheques have been mailed out to all elderly persons in Ontario who receive the federal guaranteed income supplement. The plan is designed to ensure a maximum of \$100 to any one household and to supplement benefits available under the Ontario residential property tax reduction.

In cases where husband and wife living together both receive the federal income supplement. The maximum would be \$100.

Accompanying the cheques are pamphlets explaining recipients may be eligible for a second payment of up to \$50. Also explained is how to apply for additional payment.

The program is one of two new ones launched to relieve property taxes. Second is the farm tax reduction program. Farmers will receive benefits later this month.

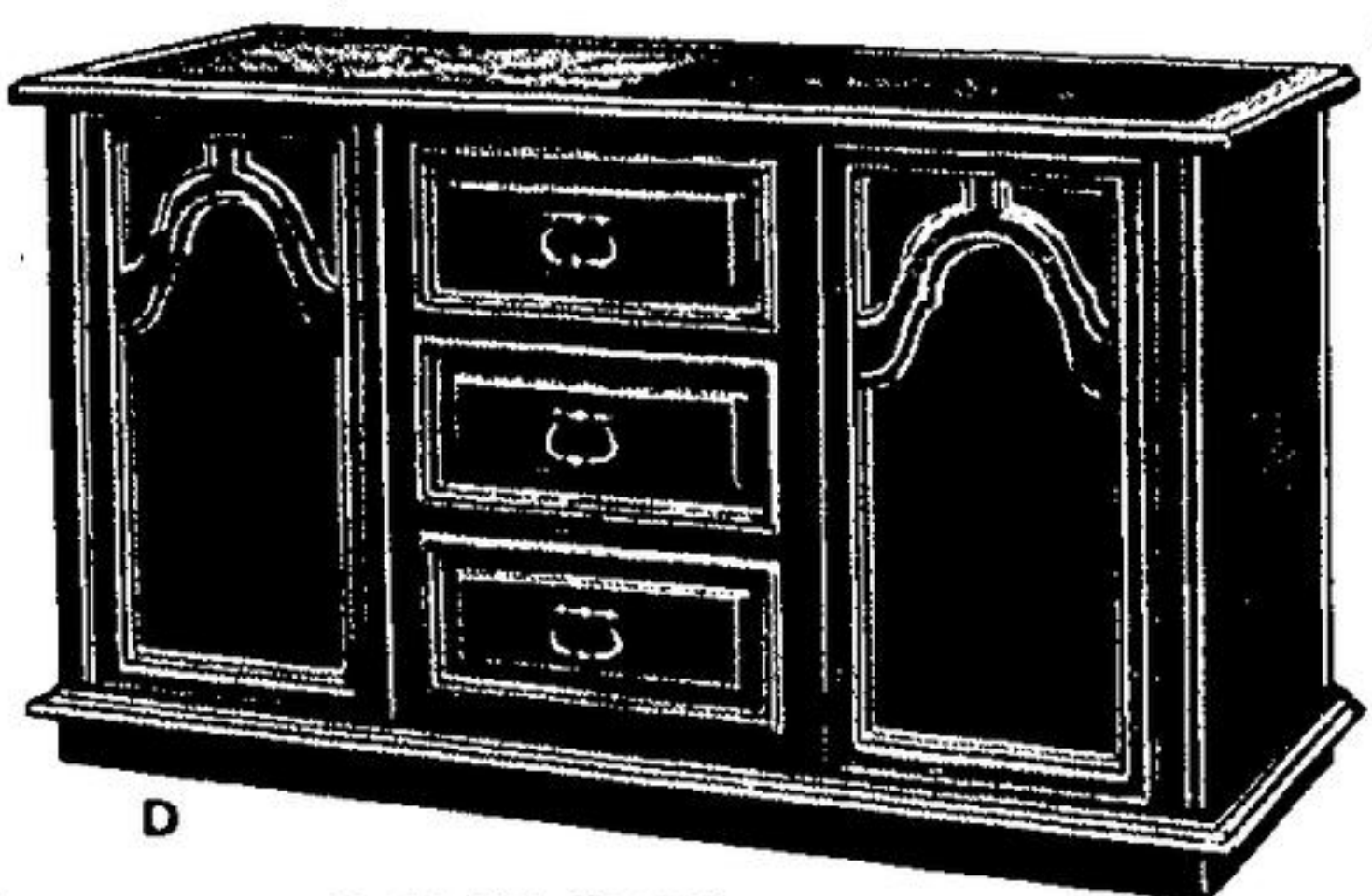

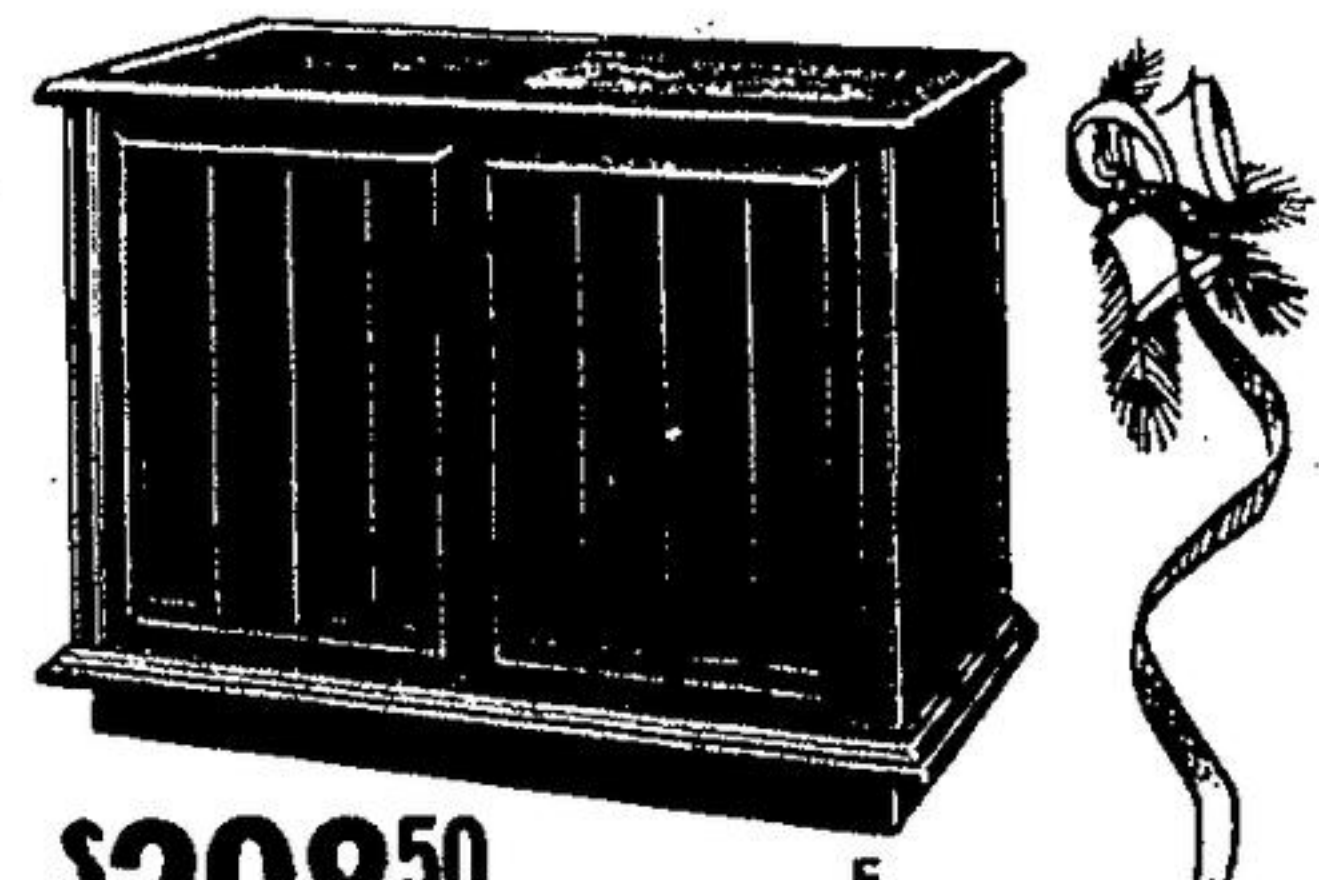
