The Corporation of the Town of Acton By-Law No. 71-1508

A By-law of the Corporation of the Town of Acton to prohibit the constructing, encumbering, injuring or fouling of highways and bridges and to prohibit the throwing, placing or depositing of dirt, glass, etcetera on any highway or bridge.

WHEREAS Section 476, Paragraph Numbers 1 and 4 of the Municipal Act, being R.S.O. 1960, Chapter 249 and amendments thereto, authorizes the Council of a municipality to pass a By-law prohibiting the obstruction, encumbering, injuring or fouling of highways or bridges, and prohibiting the throwing, placing or depositing of dirt, glass, etcetera, on highways or bridges.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Acton deems it expedient to pass such a By-law.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AS A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the Town of Acton as follows:

1. No person shall obstruct, encumber, injure or foul any public lane, highway or bridge in the Town of Acton.

2. Without in any way limiting the generality of the preceding paragraph 1, no person shall throw, place or deposit on any public lane or highway in the Town of Acton, any snow, ice, slush, dirt, filth, glass, paper, rubbish or refuse.

3. Every person who contravenes any portion of this By-law shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting judge, a penalty not exceeding (exclusive of costs), the sum of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars for each offence.
