**Protect senses is theme for Fair**

A meeting of the Halton Farm Safety Council was held on Tuesday, May 11.  
There were four entries in the Safety Poster Competition. The winners were as follows:  
4-H Section - First - Stephen Stanley of R. R. 2, Rockwood and Second - Fern Lawrence of R. R. 1, Milton.  
Public School Section - First - David Stanley and Richard Stanley was second. Both are of R. R. 2, Rockwood.  
Safety Ideas  
The council discussed ideas for

the Milton Fair Safety Displays. The theme for the displays this year will be "Protect the Senses".  
It has been suggested that a gas detector for use in detecting deadly silage gases, may be of some use in the county. The council is presently looking into the feasibility of purchasing this piece of equipment. Another suggestion was that a thermometer for measuring the temperature of hay or grain in storage may be of some use to the county. This is also being looked into.

**Continue with large committees**

In an effort to streamline the operation of county government, County Council agreed at their May meeting on Tuesday afternoon to continue with joint committee meetings.  
The joint committee includes Finance, Agriculture, Property, Office Administration, Personnel, Legislation and By-Law committees and for this month only will include Social and Family Services as well.  
The joint committee (which amounts to a committee of the whole council without two members) met for the first time last month. The streamlining was made possible when councillors changed to a salary payment rather than payment by meeting.

**Appeals permit refusal**

An application for a building permit on Lot 2, Conc. 6, made by Stanley Duchinski, will be considered in committee by Esqueping Council.  
Mr. Duchinski's original application was refused, on the grounds the property, on which he intends to build, does not have 125 feet frontage on an established road.  
Monday night, Mr. Duchinski produced a land separation he was granted by Committee of Adjustment in 1965. The by-law requiring 125 feet frontage on an established road was not passed until later.  
Reeve Tom Hill claimed the separation should have been withdrawn by the committee when the by-law was passed. "This Committee of Adjustment makes decisions then throws them into our laps," he charged.

A laneway, 66 feet wide, passes by the land on which Mr. Duchinski wishes to build.
