

Lou Bonnette joins planners

Lou Bonnette attended his first planning board meeting last Thursday and was welcomed by chairman Sid Saitz. He replaced Paul Martindale on the board. All members were present except Dave Muckle.

Three recommendations were approved to be sent to council. Planning board recommended that the official plan be amended to include provisions relating to housing conditions, as specified in the Planning Act. (This arises from the problem of deserted, run-down houses.)

The second recommendation was that the town plan be updated to show new subdivision lots.

High tension line
The third resolution recommended to council that further negotiations be established with Ontario Hydro to relocate the high tension line from H. K. Porter junction to the Eastern Ave. substation via the C.N.R. right-of-way. This would avoid having a high tension line passing through the residential section of the new Hulud subdivision.

Ontario Hydro is presently constructing a high tension line from Guelph to the H. K. Porter plant primarily along the C.N.R. right-of-way.

A copy of the motion was to be sent to Acton Hydro and Ontario Hydro.

(At council Tuesday the first two resolutions were endorsed, the third sent to committee for further study.)

ACTON COUNCIL BRIEFS

At the regular meeting Tuesday night, Acton council:

+ Passed a by-law authorizing the mayor and clerk to sign an agreement with Hulud Developments Ltd. for the erection of five model homes in the proposed Hulud subdivision on the former Seynuck farm. The houses will be built on Wallace St. Clerk Joe Hurst told council the developer will not proceed until a sub-dividers' agreement is reached.

+ Passed a by-law granting an easement for drainage purposes to Heritage Homes Ltd. for a proposed 25 house subdivision on Churchill Rd. S.

+ Authorized the clerk to pay the year's fifth financial statement amounting to \$32,163.44.

+ Accepted the recommendation of Planning Board to amend the Official Plan of Acton for the establishment of a Maintenance and Occupancy by-law and also passed a resolution to update Plot Plan 1098.

+ Passed a resolution proclaiming June 20-26 as Senior Citizens' Week in Acton. A circular received from the Minister of Social and Family Services advised that this year for the first time there will be a province-wide Senior Citizens' Week on those dates.
