The clergy speak out

"THE NEXT KINGDOM IS THE LORD'S"

Daniel 7: 27 "And the Kingdom and Dominion, and the greatness of the Kingdom under the whole Heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High whose Kingdom is an everlasting Kingdom and all dominions shall serve and obey HIM! At the very core of Communist belief is the conviction that it must conquer and rule the world.

How much more God will allow them to enslave, we do not know. But we are assured of this fact — that the next world kingdom (after the Anti-Christ's brief reign) will belong to the Lord Jesus Christ — not to Communists.

I base my convictions on the most accurate blueprint of world's history that has ever been given. Daniel's interpretation of the vision given to proud, godless King Nebuchadnezzar.
