### ESQUEWING Township Council HIGHLIGHTS

At the regular meeting Monday night, Esquewing council:

- Passed a by-law conveying part of Glen St. in Glen Williams to Henry Lorram. The street was closed by a court order.
- Passed a by-law designating the boundary line between Nassaagawa and Esquewing from Lots 22 to 23 as a through highway in order to authorize a stop sign at the end of 22 Sideroad.
- Authorized \$28,800 in estimated maintenance expenses on roads and bridges in the township.
- Passed road accounts of \$29,100.
- Was asked to identify and evaluate a barn from a picture enclosed in correspondence from a village in Saskatchewan but councilors just shook their heads and wondered what they should do. The picture was passed around the table but no one recognized the farm.
- Received a copy of a resolution from the town of Acton notifying the township they were ready to enter into an agreement with the Ontario Humane Society for the control of animals at 50c per capita, conditional on Esquewing and Georgetown also entering the agreement.
- Was notified by the Bell Canada that the company intended to rebuild a large portion of the existing telephone system in the township to provide better service, improve the appearance of roads and provide employment.
- Received a letter of thanks from the Limehouse minor sports association for the cheque in support of minor ball.
- Instructed the clerk to write G. Hildebrandt of R.R. 1, Georgetown, that the councilors feel they have answered his complaints over noise at the Golden Horseshoe Dragway and were not evading the issues he asked them to investigate. Mr. Hildebrandt wrote to council suggesting they were evading the questions he would like answered about noise control at the dragstrip.
- Listened to a "weed report" from the county weed inspector disclosing he was disappointed as a result of a tour through the county that some municipalities were not spraying at all to keep weeds down. Councilors again shook their heads in wonder. Councilor Howitt said, "I thought we were not supposed to spray." Road superintendent Bud Snow said that was the word at first but later developments were that spraying part of the township was all right. Eramosa and Erin townships sprayed the entire areas as usual, he noted.
- Agreed to send the Department of Mines and Northern Affairs a copy of the township holding by-law and the proposed official plan following receipt of a letter notifying the township Consolidated Sand and Gravel was asking for a permit to operate a quarry on 100 acres on Lots 11 and 12 Con. 1, and Lots 12, 13 and 14, Con. 2. The Department wanted to know if any township by-laws or parts of the official plan which would limit operation of the quarry.
- Received a complaint by telephone from Mr. G. Moore about alleged violation of the township by-law regulating hours at the Golden Horseshoe Dragway.
- Advice from the township solicitor to council was that the holding by-law supersedes any other township by-law in regard to trailers at the Silver Springs Motel.
- Deputy Reeve Russell Miller acted as Reeve for the four hour meeting in the absence of Reeve Tom Hill.
