

ACTON COUNCIL BRIEFS

Council considered various items at their short meeting Tuesday, most of them arising from the minutes of committee meetings held the week before.

-Councillor Norm Elliott will read all Credit Valley Conservation Authority minutes and bring pertinent matters to council's attention. The minutes will also be available to others, in the normal procedure.

-The clerk will discuss with engineers the matter of sewer lateral connections in the Heritage Homes subdivision, in an effort to keep the lateral road cut to a minimum.
