**Fergus goes "wet"**

In municipal elections last week, Milton voters turned down fluoridation by almost 3-1 and Fergus went "Wet" after a 37 year "dry" spell.

The Milton electorate also turned down opening of pool rooms on Sunday afternoons, turned out the incumbent deputy-reeve and elected two new councillors. Bob McCaughy replaced Percy Barr in the deputy's chair while Marjorie Poyas and Dr. Ivan Hunter were elected to council. Veteran Charlie Johnson was defeated in his attempt to serve his 17th year on council.

While it was generally conceded fluoridation would not get the necessary majority the 1,284 to 456 margin was more substantial than most voters anticipated. Sunday pool was turned down 993 to 714.

Fergus voters turned that town "wet" with a 70.3 per cent vote in favor of selling liquor under a dining room lounge license. 1411 against 597 opposed. On the sale of liquor for consumption on licensed premises, 1,316 voted Yes against 683 No.

There have been three Fergus referendums on liquor in the last

required 60 per cent majority was not reached.

The "wet" outlook was encouraged by the weather on polling day — pouring rain.
