When I run into a bidding problem with my favorite partner, I wonder how many other partnerships have the same problem. Playing rubber bridge the other evening, I made a reopening double which was passed out for a poor result.

By now everyone should be familiar with the take-out or cooperative double. This is a double of an opponents bid made at the first opportunity, to double. It shows an opening bid plus support for all unbid suits.

The re-opening double is made after the opponents have signed off at a low level contract. Here is the example from the rubber bridge match that I mentioned. South dealt with Enst-West
