Choose safe toys

Toys—from a rubber ball to a shiny new bicycle—are a part of growing up and the child without a toy or two, or two dozen, at Christmas is a forlorn lot indeed. Most youngsters will open their gifts Christmas morning and have a large time getting acquainted with their new toys. But in all too many households across the nation, the toys themselves will dim the happy Christmas season, by causing accidents and injuries.

Tips

Here are a few simple tips to guide you in selecting safe toys:

Beware of small toys that can be swallowed, flammable toys and toys with rough or sharp edges.

Safe toys

All electric toys should be safe. Look for the UL (Underwriters Laboratory) label on the cord and the toy itself.

Avoid toys made of lead or colored with lead-based paints. The swallowing of poisonous amounts of lead by children who chew that paint off can cause illness.

Baby's toys should be too large to put in the mouth, washable, lightweight and non-brITTLE.
