At their January meeting Erin Township council:

-Was informed natural gas heating for the fire hall would cost about \$2,000 for a complete job or \$1,400 plus material if the duct work was left till later. Council chose the latter.

-Heard also, that the plumbing had cost approximately \$1,337 to date, and would be another \$300 to finish.

-Discussed the request of Eramosa township and the Village of Erin to look for a joint garbage site.

Ask more grant

The Township of Nassagaweya intends to ask for an additional allotment under the Provincial Municipal Incentives Plan. At a meeting of council Monday night it was learned the township had been granted an initial \$2,751 under the program.

The township intends to apply for an added grant upwards to \$5,000. Clerk Campbell Thompson told council it might receive an additional 30 per cent on the original grant and that it might even receive more.

No definite work projects have been planned under the program, although cutting dead elms was mentioned by council as one of the tasks that could be undertaken. Reeve Mrs. Anne MacArthur also suggested building a refreshment booth on the ball land park located beside the Township buildings.






