Each of these committee chairmen are responsible for organizing activities falling within the committee at the club level on a county basis.

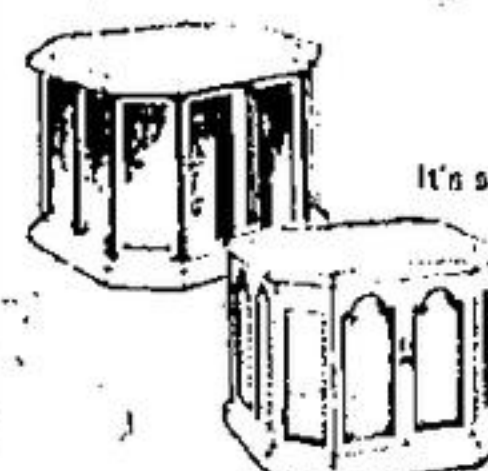

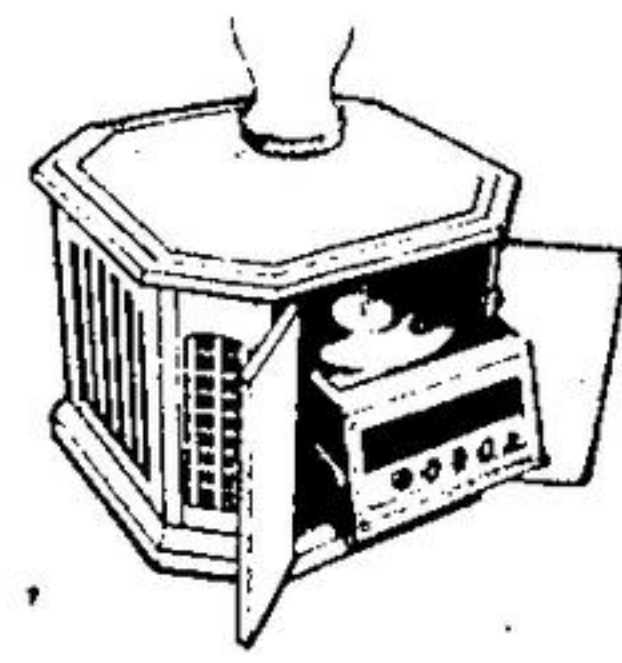

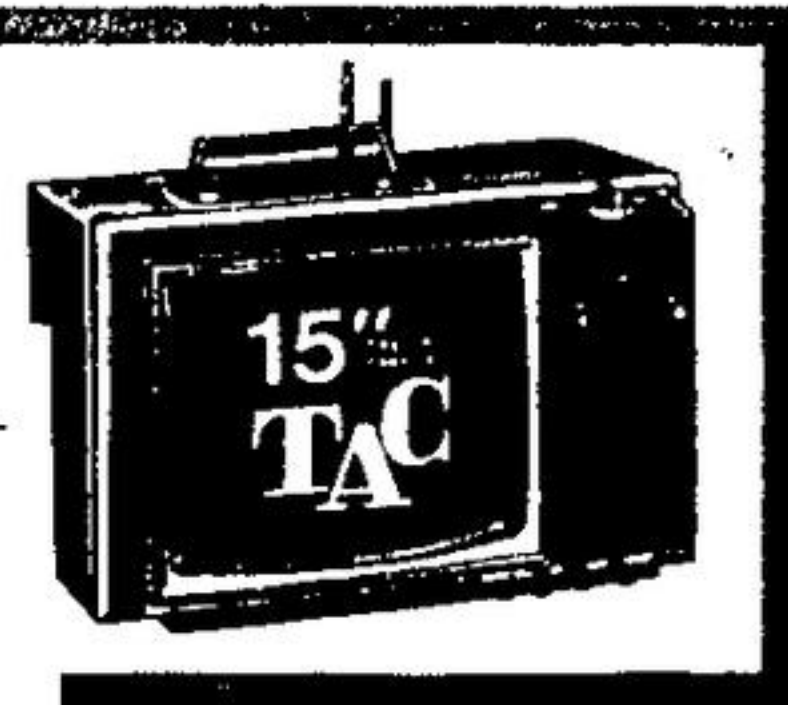
