represented by me and with your support, I'll represent it again," he concluded.

Berryman confident Berryman said he was confident he could bring sound municipal perspective to the federal scene. He said governments at all levels must commit themselves to achieving the lowest possible unemployment figure.

Berryman said as mayor of Burlington he had asked the federal government to allow the town representation on the Hamilton Harbor Commission, but had been unsuccessful.

Benson absent Former finance Minister Edgar Benson, now minister of national defence who was scheduled to be the guest speaker was unable to attend because of the air traffic problem. He sent his regrets in a telegram. Health minister John Munro, M.P. for Hamilton East also missed the meeting, because of air traffic difficulties.
