## Erin twp. council

At the April meeting, Erin township council:

—Informed of the possibility that the private school charter held by Everdale Place had been rescinded, Council discussed closing up the "commune" as they had heard people were living in a barn.

—Received a request from the Minor Hockey Association for the final payment of \$197. It was commented that this was \$2 per hour more than last year.

—Suggested Reeve Lloyd Lang attend an Acton meeting to discuss fire boundaries, along with Councillor Harold Griffin, as there was some question of cost sharing.

—Passed a motion to join the newly formed Association of Municipalities of Ontario, and to forward the \$45 fee.

—Was informed the 1972 Grand River Conservation levy was \$6,637.97.

—Received a letter from Joe Gilby asking approval to locate a trout fishery on his 25 acres. Mr. Gilby stated that this would be consistent with land use, and the water used would be obtained by catching spring water to form a head pond.

Passed a motion designating the Spring daylight saving time change be at 12.01 a.m., April 30.

—Discussed the request from Wellington County for two sponsored delegates to be sent to the 1973 Fire School set up by the Fire Marshall's office. The reeve commented that the "Sponsorship" would include paying not only expenses but also the week's wages for the men off work. He suggested Councillor Bert Wheeler discuss it at the firemen's next meeting.

—Passed a motion to send \$50 for repairs to the Orton skating rink after receiving a letter from secretary Mrs. Bill Neiles asking for a donation. Reeve Lang stated that he'd heard the roof was "desperately in need of attention."

—Instructed building inspector Jim Delaney to take action under new bylaws to clean up "places resembling junk yards." The Hillsburgh trustees will also be asked for their suggestions and recommendations as to who should head the list. Township lawyer Hungerford will send registered letters to these.














The Judo program is still hanging in the air until we get an instructor but we hope to soon have it under way.
