The Corporation of the Town of Acton  
to dispense with a Vote of the Electors

Take Notice That:

- The Council of the Corporation of the Town of Acton intends to apply to the Ontario Municipal Board for approval of the reconstruction of Bower Street, from Willow Street to Mill Street, in order to improve the roadway and intersections to acceptable standards. The following works are required:
  - Excavation to new subgrade
  - Place granular base course
  - Place catchbasins and connect to existing sewer system
  - Construct curbs and sidewalks
  - Construct asphalt pavement
  - Sod disturbed areas
- The length of the proposed works is 1750 feet at an estimated cost of \$99,409.93, whereof the amount of \$60,936.96 shall be raised by the sale of debentures payable out of the general rate over a period not exceeding ten years.
- Application will be made to the Ontario Municipal Board for an order to dispense with the assent of the electors to the undertaking of the said works. Any ratepayer may, within twenty-one days after the first publication of this notice, send by post pre-paid to the Clerk of the Town of Acton, at the address given below, a notice in writing stating his objection to such approval and the grounds of such objection.
- The Ontario Municipal Board may order pursuant to the statute that the assent of the electors shall not be required and may approve of the said works, but before doing so it may appoint a time and place for a public hearing when any objections will be considered.

## Y.M.C.A. News and Happenings

We are making another stab at trying to get the Day Camp program off the ground. We feel it has much to offer both to the youngsters and to the mothers who will be climbing the walls by August.

We will have four periods, each from 8.30 to 5 p.m. daily, Monday to Friday. Transportation will be included in the weekly charge of \$8 for members. Youngsters bring their own lunch or cook-out supplies and we supply the beverage. You have your choice of one, two, three or four periods in which to enroll your youngsters.

30 minimum  
Unfortunately in order to break even we need a minimum enrolment of 30 campers per period or we will be forced to cancel out the one which is below minimum or all if there is no interest.

The periods are July 31 to Aug. 4, Aug. 7 to 11, Aug. 14 - 18 and Aug. 21 - 25. Our leaders have attended a training program in Guelph.



There are registration forms available from schools, banks or Y.M.C.A. Please do remember that we have to know by July 14 how many youngsters will be registered in order to set up programs, how large a staff we'll need, etc.

We are looking at this with a positive approach and hope we don't get a negative reaction. Blue Springs is a beautiful spot; we hope to teach the youngsters much about nature, archery, relating to each other, and camping skills.
