The Council of the Corporation of the Town of Acton intends to apply to the Ontario Municipal Board for approval of the reconstruction of Bower Street, from Willow Street to MIII Street, in order to improve the roadway and intersections to acceptable standards. The following works are required: -

Excavation to new subgrade Place granular base course Place catchbasins and connect to existing sewer system Construct curbs and sidewalks Construct asphalt pavement

Sod disturbed areas The length of the proposed works is 1750 feet at

an estimated cost of \$99,409.93, whereof the amount of \$60,936.96 shall be raised by the sale of debentures payable out of the general rate over a period not exceeding ten years.

- 2. Application will be made to the Ontario Municipal Board for an order to dispense with the assent of the electors to the undertaking of the said works. Any ratepayer may, within twenty-one days after the first publication of this notice, send by post pre-paid to the Clerk of the Town of Acton, at the address given below, a notice in writing stating his objection to such approval and the grounds of such objection.
- 3. The Ontario Municipal Board may order pursuant to the statute that the assent of the electors shall not be required and may approve of the said works, but before doing so it may appoint a time and place for a public hearing when any objections will be considered.




