### Notice of Application by The Corporation of the Town of Acton to dispense with a Vote of the Electors

Take Notice That:

1. The Council of the Corporation of the Town of Acton intends to apply to the Ontario Municipal Board for approval of the reconstruction of Bower Street, from Willow Street to Mill Street, in order to improve the roadway and intersections to acceptable standards. The following works are required:-

- Excavation to new subgrade
- Place granular base course
- Place catchbasins and connect to existing sewer system
- Construct curbs and sidewalks
- Construct asphalt pavement
- Sod disturbed areas

The length of the proposed works is 1750 feet at an estimated cost of \$99,409.93, whereof the amount of \$60,936.96 shall be raised by the sale of debentures payable out of the general rate over a period not exceeding ten years.

2. Application will be made to the Ontario Municipal Board for an order to dispense with the assent of the electors to the undertaking of the said works. Any ratepayer may, within twenty-one days after the first publication of this notice, send by post pre-paid to the Clerk of the Town of Acton, at the address given below, a notice in writing stating his objection to such approval and the grounds of such objection.

3. The Ontario Municipal Board may order pursuant to the statute that the assent of the electors shall not be required and may approve of the said works, but before doing so it may appoint a time and place for a public hearing when any objections will be considered.

### ACTON Municipal Council ACTIVITIES

At a regular meeting, Tuesday June 27, Acton Council dealt with the following items of business:

— Council engaged Domtree Sales Ltd. to repaint pavement markings at the Mill-Main intersection according to drawings approved by the Department of Transportation and Communication.

— After consulting with the deputy city clerk of Guelph, deputy clerk Grant Usher informed public works committee that conditions on the entrance and exits cannot be imposed on a business unless they are attached to the site plan during rezoning. Councillors

Coats and Elliott have been particularly concerned about the traffic bottleneck which results on Mill St. from cars exiting from the Foodland and Canadian Tire parking lots.

## Acton Witnesses to attend large Fort Erie assembly

"Let's forget about each one doing his own thing and for a constructive change, let's each one help his neighbor do the right thing. That's what this assembly is all about," says Kevin Gourlay, 16-year-old minister in training and active member of the Acton congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses.  
 Kevin will be one of 34 delegates from the Acton congregation who will attend the four-day "Divine Rulership" District Assembly of Jehovah's Witnesses scheduled for the Fort Erie Race Track, July 13 to 16. It is expected that a very large portion of the 10,000 persons expected to attend will be made up of teenagers.  
 Kevin and young friends from the Acton area expect to be among the many hundreds of volunteer workers who will contribute to the successful organization of the four-day Witness gathering. Among duties to be performed, much of which will be

cared for by youthful delegates, will be sweeping, cleaning, kitchen duties, guides and attendants.

Anarchy result  
 Kevin says "Youths today recognize that modern governments have failed to rid the earth of war, suffering, oppression by large business empires or crime syndicates. The solution, however, is not in rebellion against all authority, which only leads to anarchy. Vocal or violent dissent most often only compounds the problem. Respect for properly-constituted, deserving authority, and that, to us, is the authority of Jehovah God himself is the only remedy."  
 Among other things, delegates to the Witness convention will be taught that divine authority is the solution. The public discourse for Sunday afternoon is entitled "Divine Rulership the Only Hope of All Mankind."  
 "We can all recognize that like it or not, we are subject to laws;

total freedom does not exist. Ignore gravity, jump off a cliff and you don't survive. We have to be subject in so many ways and whether we like it or not, that subject is to a divine law. We are subject to God," Witnesses say, asking "Why not then expand that subject to other fields; fields of daily behavior, especially when the benefits for doing so are so rewarding?"

### Publishers write — 30 —

With last week's issue of the Erin Advocate, the Hull family ended three generations' association with the paper. Wellington Hill, Roy Hull and presently Charlie Hull through the years since 1894 produced the newspaper for Erin and district. Now the paper has been sold to Bill Doole, former newspaperman who has been teaching journalism at Sheridan college.  
 In a front page editorial, the Hulls write "30 — to their publishing career."  
 "We have endeavored through the years to produce a worthy newspaper for Erin and surrounding communities — not with the flamboyancy of the daily, which often causes grief and degradation to pride and character, but in a plain and truthful manner, with malice toward none. We feel that in this we have attained a measure of success," the editorial states.
