The Council of the Township of Esquering, in co-operation with the Ministry of Transportation and Communications of the Province of Ontario, is examining all local roads and streets in the Municipality for the purpose of developing a logical long-range improvement programme.

The determination of traffic volumes on the Township Roads is an essential part of the Study and is based on actual counts at selected locations.
