That question is being put to the people for the second time. The first time it was put on the ballot by the council and defeated. This time it is there at the request of the Jockey Club.



The proposed 500,000 volt Ontario Hydro power corridor received a setback recently when

Commission chairman Dr. Omond Solandt suggested the Howlett study should put primary emphasis on environmental factors in key areas such as the crossing of the Niagara escarpment in making the route selection. He said the aim is not to choose what is theoretically the best route but to choose a good route along which the line can be built quickly with the minimum of environmental

damage and local opposition. The December 7 meeting will be held in the Huron Room, MacDonald Block of Queen's Park on Wellesley St.


