Railway museum closes operations until spring

The last day of operation for the Halton County Radial Railway at its Nassagaweya site was

October 29 when three of the vintage electric cars were used to ferry passengers across the railway museum property. Car 4000 was pressed into service joining cars 8 and 55 to close down the operation until the spring of 1973.

"It is difficult to imagine three cars that could present a wider variety of types," the most recent newsletter of the Ontario Electric Railway Historical association comments.

The Association recently purchased the body of the TTC steel light-weight car 416 to add to the collection for the operation.

This car was built by the Ottawa Car Co. in 1924 and was last used on the North Yonge Railways between Richmond Hill and Toronto in October, 1948. The body has been used as a Hillsburgh home since that time.

"It has been well cared for and inspection showed the structure to be in excellent condition. Older members have had their eye on this body ever since the museum was founded, and we are pleased we have finally been able to acquire it," the bulletin says.

The Association is also negotiating for unusual Taylor low-floor trucks available in the United States.

In its first year of operation the Association expects that figures will show over 8,000 paid passengers on the Halton county radial line. The average passenger load for each Sunday of operation was over 500.

New equipment in switch centre

New Automatic Number Identification (A.N.I.) equipment is being installed in the Acton switching centre to speed up long distance calling. Lloyd Denby, Bell Canada Manager in this area commented.

Callers' telephone numbers will be automatically recorded when self-dialed long distance calls are placed. The operator will no longer have to ask for the telephone number.

The new A.N.I. service applies only to customers with individual or two-party line service. However, some individual and two-party line customers in the rural areas will still have to give their number to the Operator.

Those on multi-party lines will also be required to give their telephone number on direct dialed calls.
