"A Store" is a place where Sheridan students can display and sell their wares. Sponsored by the student senates at the Oakville campus, A Store carries items such as leather bags and belts, fashions and pottery. As well as selling student-made goods, A store sells records, magazines and paperbacks at discount prices. Students name their own prices and the store takes a 10 per cent commission on goods sold. The store opened in March and, according to Media Arts student Marty Herzog, coordinator of the project, sales are increasing each day. During the first two hours of operation \$47 worth of goods were sold. The store is run by students on a volunteer basis and is open weekdays during lunch time.
