Counselling

Full-time professional counsellors are employed by the college to assist prospective and current students with career planning, academic concerns, personal and other matters. Confidential discussions can be arranged by calling the Counselling office at Brampton or Oakville campus.



Effective in September, the Credit Valley School of Nursing in Mississauga and its 200 student nurses will come under the wing of Sheridan College. For the past two years Sheridan has been teaching non-professional subjects such as English and psychology at the Credit Valley nursing school.

It is not expected that there will be major changes in the nursing education curriculum in the academic year ahead. Integration with the relevant college programs is expected to be gradual, in consultation with local advisory groups.

For this year, high school students will apply as



they have in the past, to the Credit Valley School of Nursing on the standard application form provided by the College of Nurses.

Fees for the student nurses will remain at \$250 for the 1973/74 academic year, the same as for other students enrolled in community colleges. Student nurses will be eligible for financial assistance under the Ontario Student Awards Program on the same basis as other post-secondary students.

According to the Ontario ministry, the reason for the transfer is to give student nurses an opportunity for a broader general education.
