Nassagaweya insists on join Milton

A growing concern about the top portion of Nassagaweya has led Nassagaweya Reeve Anne MacArthur and her Council to reaffirm a stand taken earlier that would have all of the township together under regional government.

Nassagaweya Council had adopted that position originally and later agreed that the portion at the top end of the township in the vicinity of Eden Mills should go with Eramosa and Wellington County in a regional government setup.

According to the most recent brief submitted by Nassagaweya, the council wanted all but the northern section to be included in the central borough.

All or nothing

The northern borough which includes Acton, Esquesing and Georgetown did not want the northern section of the township unless they could have the land further south which contained the bulk of the township's assessment.

Milton Council has agreed to a merger with all but the northern part of Nassagaweya in a central borough but town councillors have never publicly said they were interested in having the whole township form a part of the central borough.

"No one wants us without our assessment," Reeve MacArthur said, indicating that who and her council agreed that the township should stay intact.
