Replace bridge?
Parks manager Harold Townsley was instructed to get prices and other information regarding a permanent type bridge at the mouth of the school creek. The bridge joins a walkway from Elizabeth Drive to Prospect Park.
Foundations of the bridge were washed out this Spring, making it unsafe, and Mr. Townsley reported he was concerned it would wash out again if it was put back the same way.
"We haven't got the equipment to build the bridge properly," he told members of Parks Board at the regular June meeting Thursday.
"See if you can get a price on a permanent type bridge. It is pointless to keep repairing," suggested member Gil Malcolm. The board discussed the merits of acquiring a bridge such as spans the creek in front of the public library before asking Mr. Townsley to investigate prices and structures.
Several members of the board said they had calls from citizens who use the bridge, asking the board to get it back in place.
