## O.P.P. report

### Need licenses for trail bikes

During the reporting week of August 5 to August 12, officers of the Acton detachment of the Ontario Provincial Police, investigated a total of 40 general occurrences. There were no motor vehicle collisions reported. Occurrences investigated ranged from requests for assistance to reports of suspicious persons. There were no reports of major occurrences.

Three out of town men were charged for violations of the liquor control act when the vehicle they occupied was made subject of a routine check.

Two local men were charged with "loitering" under a town by-law, after they had received repeated warnings about the offence.

Must be licensed  
A local youth was charged with driving without insurance, when he was checked while operating a trail bike on a town street. Trail bikes, like cars, must be licensed and insured and the operator must be the holder of a drivers license before the vehicles can be operated on the road.

## Let's talk about HORSES

Question: What is a thrush? What are the causes and the cure?  
Answer: Thrush is a soft, smelly, black exudate around the frog of the foot usually caused by foul wet matter staying in the clefts of the frog too long. If horses are left standing in an unclean stall without regular foot cleaning, thrush often appears. However, it can also come when a chunk of manure gets packed in the cleft by mud. The preventative is to pick out the hooves every day, keep stalls dry and clean and let the horse run out daily. If the frog begins to smell and look greasy, don't pick at it, but pour a disinfectant, such as watered crooline or absorbine, on it and pack the hoof with pine tar to keep the muck away from it. A bad case needs vet or farrier care. A neglected case can develop into hoof rot.

Question: Is there any way to lengthen a horse's stride at the walk?  
Answer: Yes, give the horse lots of road work at a brisk walk. While walking, nudge his elbow as he puts that foreleg out, with

## Obituary

### Ivan G. Chalmers was well-known here

After a period of failing health, Ivan G. Chalmers passed away peacefully at Beverly Street Nursing Home, Toronto, on Saturday, July 28. A brief funeral service was held at the Marley S. Bedford Funeral Home on Tuesday, July 31, followed by cremation.

Mr. Chalmers was born at Dundee, Scotland on January 7, 1896. In August, 1914, he enlisted in the famous 51st Highland Division as a signaller, attached to the Field Artillery, serving thus until April, 1919. He saw active service in France for four years.

Leaving his native land of Scotland in 1921, he, with his brother, Robert, who also served for a similar period in France, came to Canada. From 1921 until August, 1940, Mr. Chalmers was engaged for most of the time in a bookkeeping capacity with several businesses in Mount Forest, Ontario.

**Second war**  
He served in the Second World War with the Royal Canadian Army Service Corps at St. Thomas and London, Ontario, being attached most of that time to the R.C.A.F. base at St. Thomas. He was demobilized in April, 1947. For two years he was with the War Assets Corporation and 10 years with the Canadian Cornstock Company. He left the R.C.A.S.C. with the rank of Staff Sergeant.

On Dec. 10, 1959, he enrolled with the Canadian Corps of Commissioners and was immediately posted to the pay and Account Branch of the Corps office in Toronto, from which position he retired on December 31, 1969.

**Lodge member**  
Mr. Chalmers was a member of Fairlawn United Church, Toronto. He was a valued member of Mount Forest Lodge, A.F. & A.M., was a Past Master of the same Lodge, and a Past District Deputy Grand Master of Wellington District, previous to his years of service in the Second World War. To the last, he maintained an interest in Masonic ideals and activities. He was a frequent visitor to Acton at the home of his sister, with Rev. and Mrs. Walter Fushury and family. When Mr. Fushury was minister of Acton United Church, he frequently sang solos there and duets with his sister.
