George Bernard Shaw, the irascible playwright, has written a witty comment on English society which director Jim Gordon is fashioning into a heady mixture of comedy and tense melodrama where dual feelings of laughter and tears

The plot brings in the inevitable triangle where George Fitztollemache (Fitz) determines to do away with his wife's boy friend, the dashing and urbane young Alphonse and the events which foul up his best efforts.

It is a first effort for the Eramosa players who hope the impetus from the play will keep a theatre group functioning in the township.

They are being assisted in this venture by T.H.E.M. (Theatre Happenings in Eden Mills) the youth group which has been presenting plays in Rockwood and Eden Mills throughout the summer as well as introducing children to the theatre with classes.

Jim Gordon, son of Mr. and Mrs. Don Gordon of R.R. 5, Rockwood, agreed to direct the first play of the Eramosa Players and assist them in getting started.

The curtain goes up at 8 p.m. There is a small admission charge of 50 cents and one dollar.


