Name volunteer co-ordinator for Halton Children's Aid

Nancy Ross has been hired by the Halton Children's Aid Society as volunteer co-ordinator. This is a part-time position previously handled by three volunteers.

Mrs. Ross has her master's degree in social work. A resident of Burlington for the past year and a half, she previously worked as the director of a day care centre at the University of Michigan.

The centre was staffed entirely by volunteers, enabling Nancy to gain experience in community organization. Her job with CAS will be as llaison between the agency and the existing volunteer groups.

The CAS auxillary was formed in 1971 under the leadership of Mrs. Catherine Walsh, It was felt that the needs of the clients would be better served by involved

people in the community. Volunteers are used as drivers, case-aid workers, office librarian, evening receptionist, and group coordinators.




