Dead elms in the district have been cut down lately.

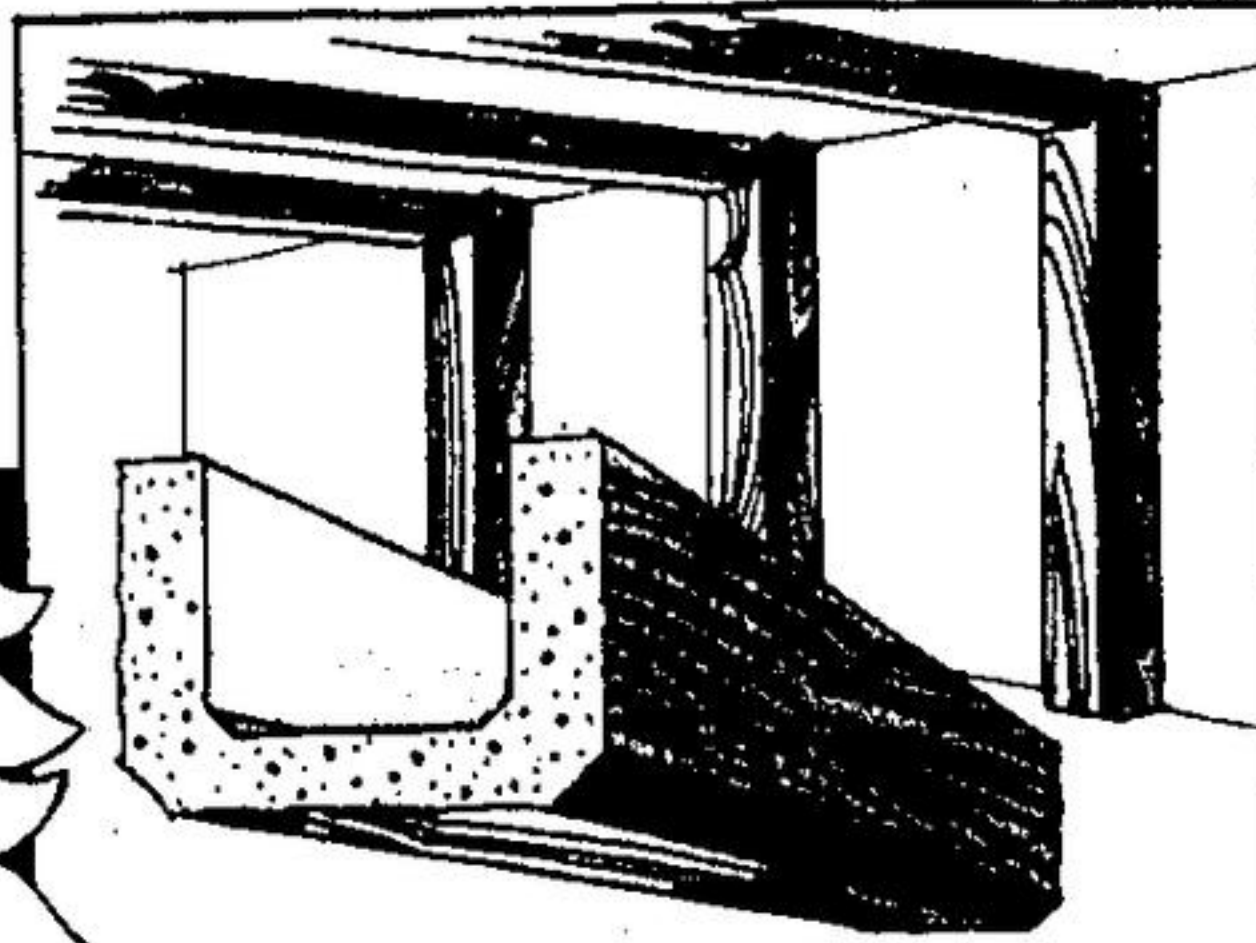
