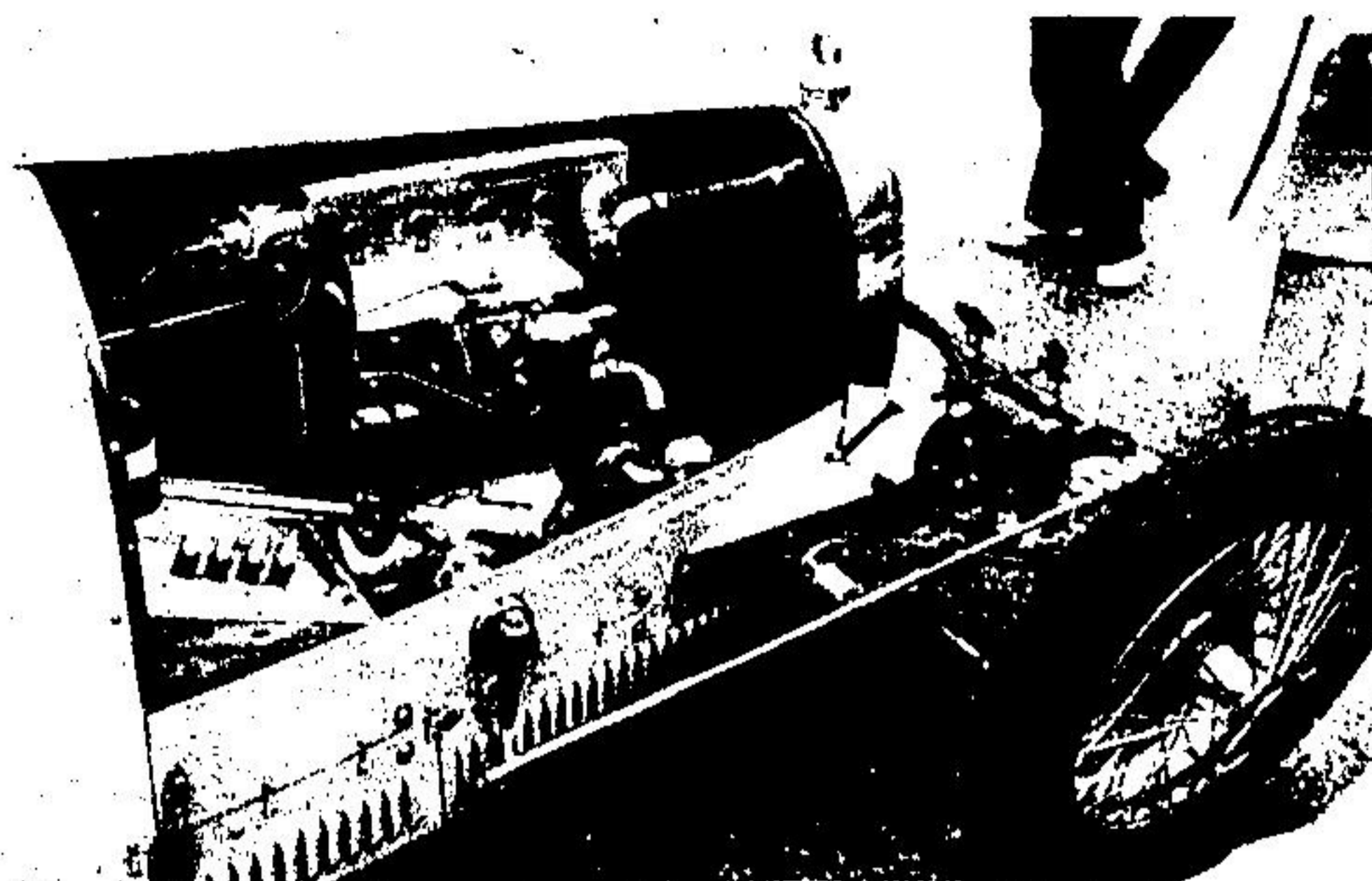


Proud and polished Cadillac.



One of many sports cars was a 1927 Bugatti T37 Grand Prix.

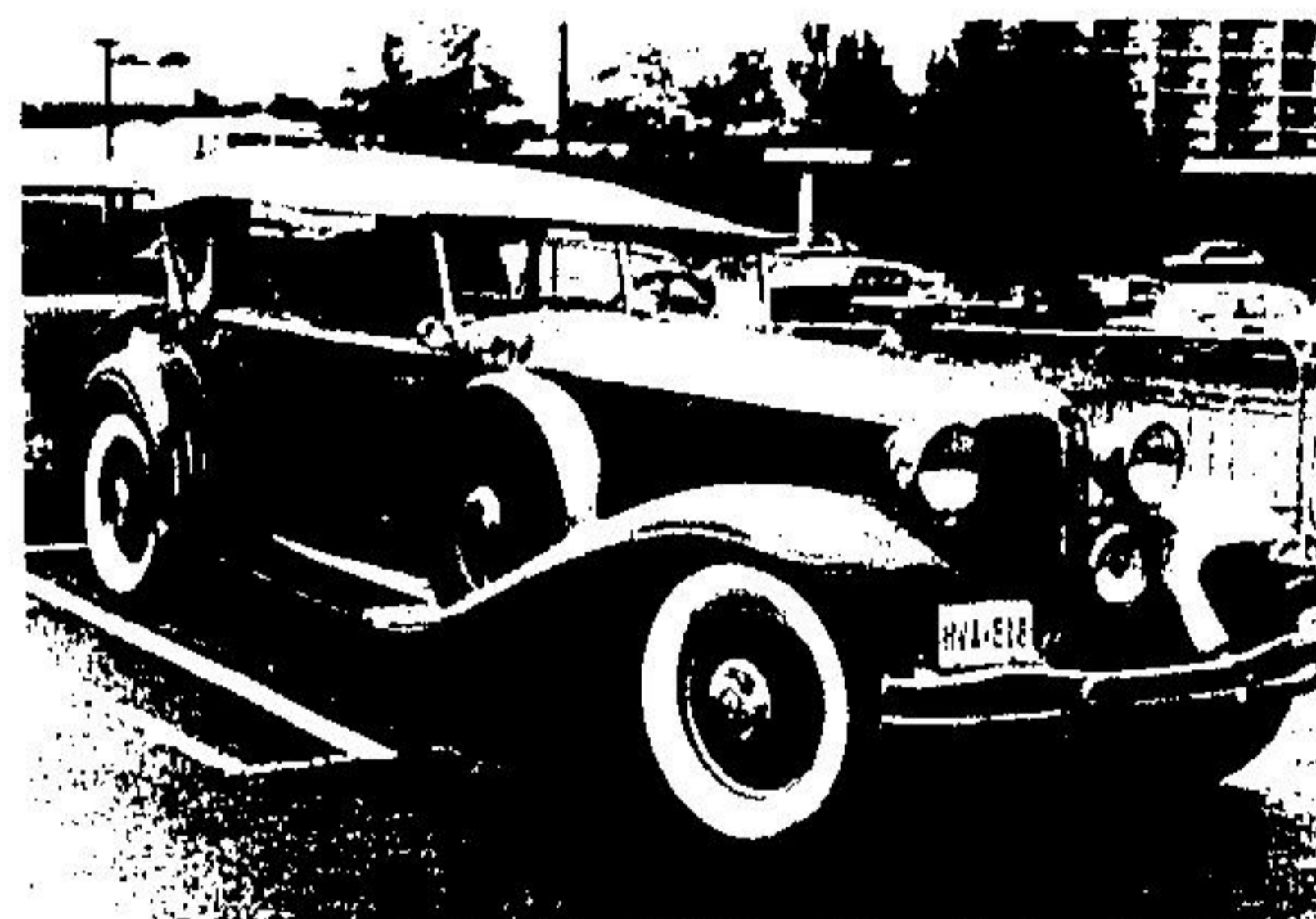


A 1904 Ford was one of the earliest cars at the show.

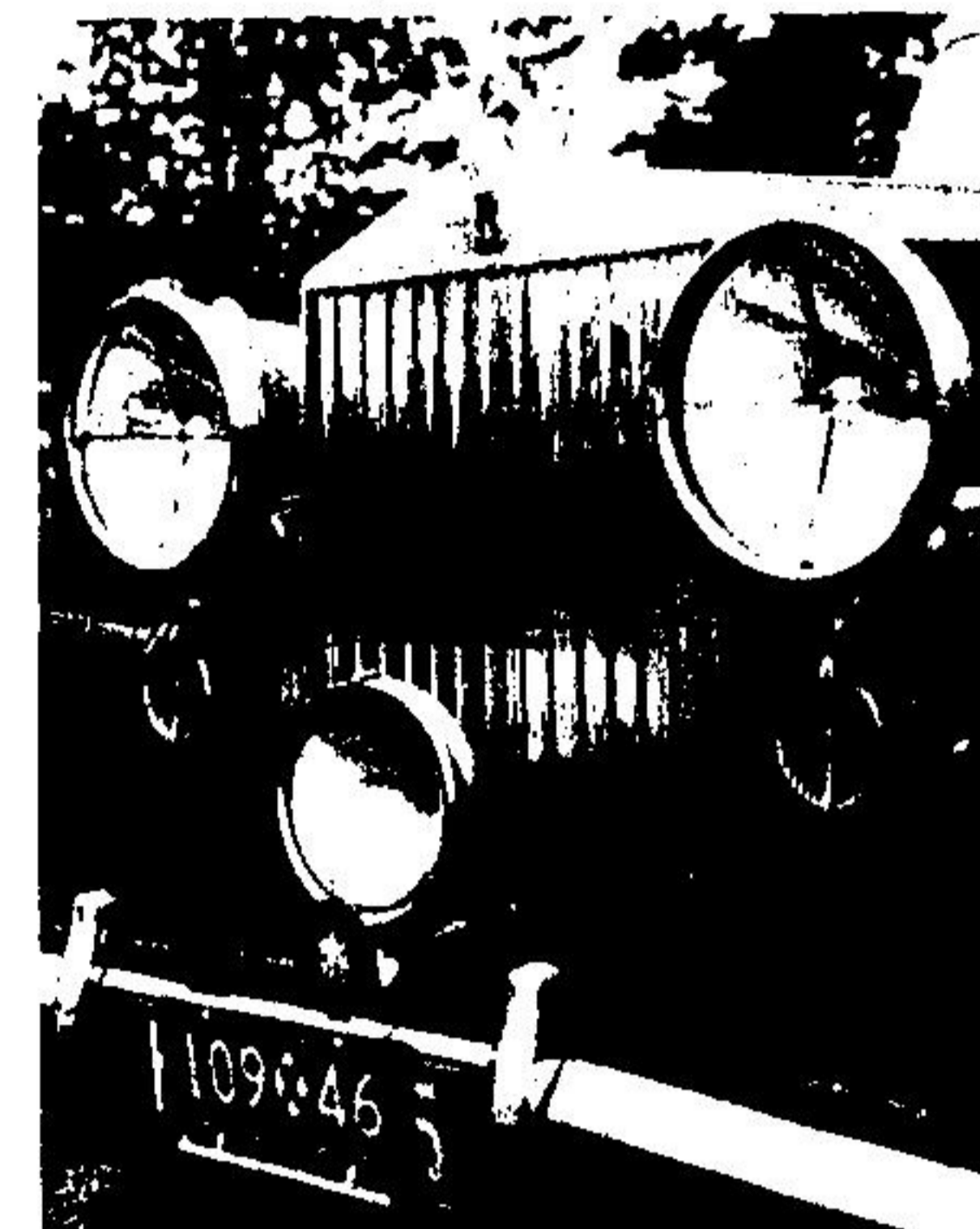
Nostalgia on wheels

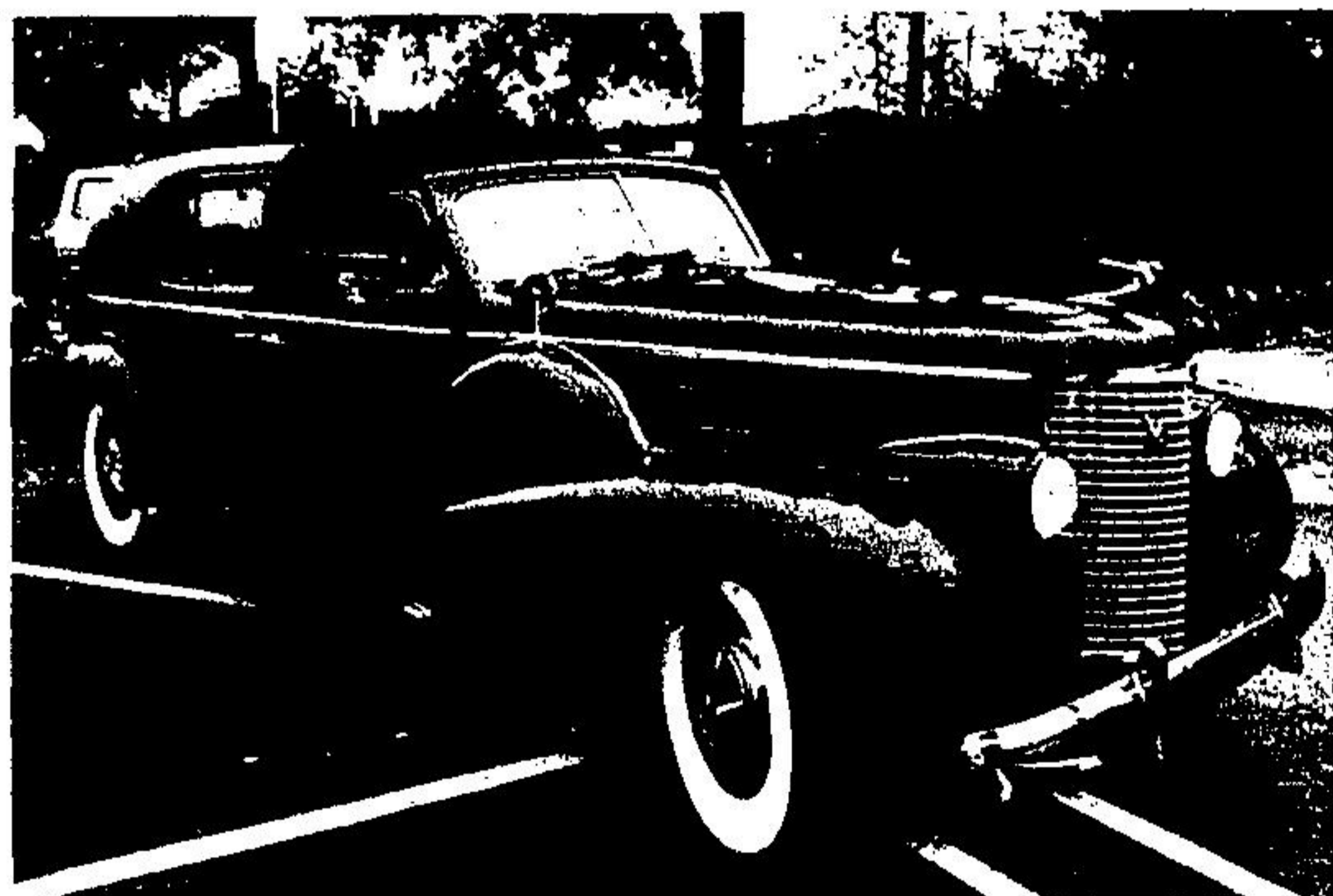

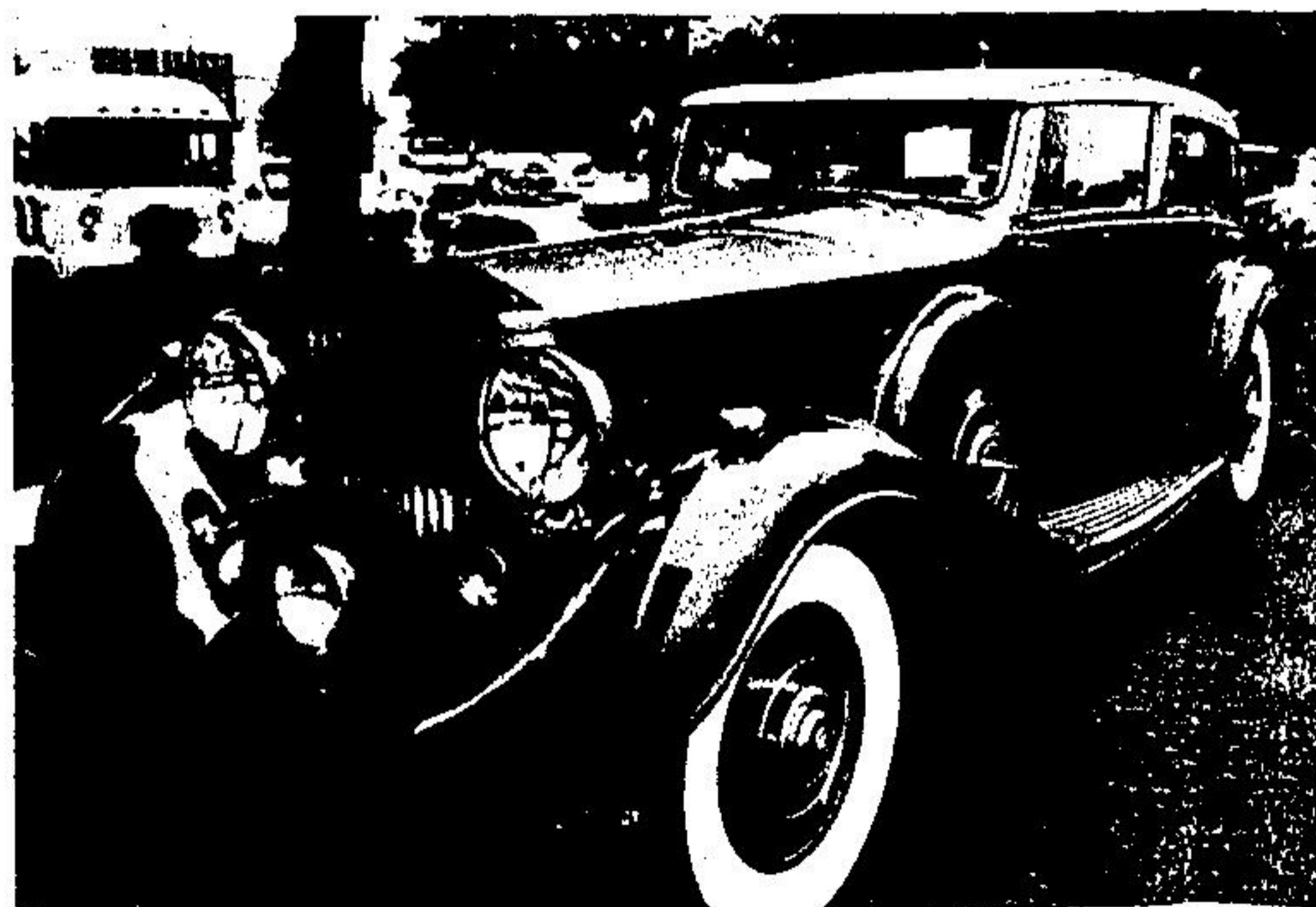

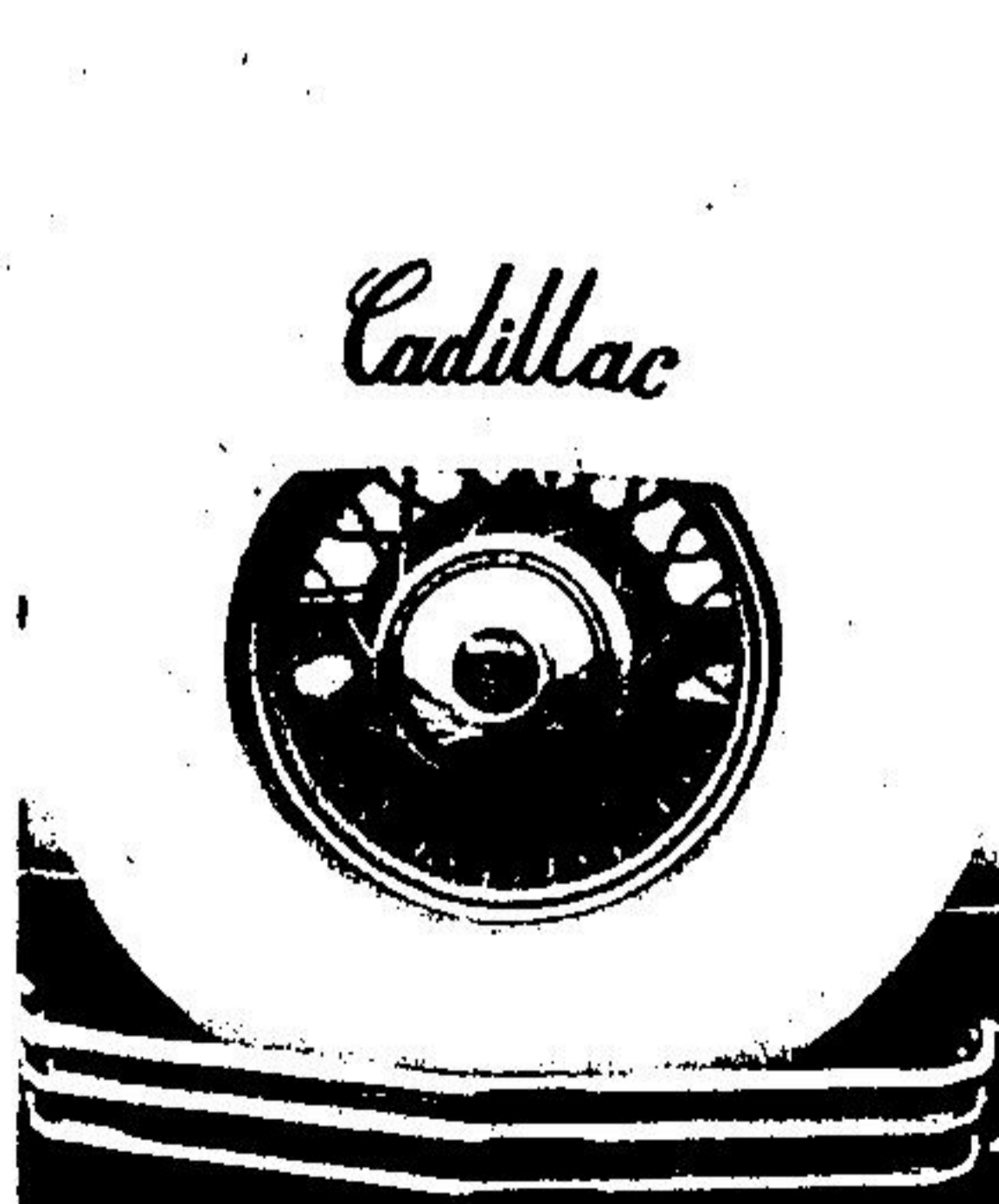
