Region dumps in poor shape

Landfill sites in Halton Region are in need of improvement according to public works chairman Jack Raftis. Raftis was commenting on a report from the Ministry of the Environment. The report delineated findings of the ministry after examinations of each of the sites. The report according to Raftis indicated many areas where improvements were needed. Copies of the report were not available at that time. The committee did approve the hiring of consultants to study the leachate problem at the Oakville dump. According to the ministry leachate from the dump is having a significant and detrimental effect on the stream quality.

No dough for station

Halton's Finance and Administration Committee won't offer any assistance to Milton Chamber of Commerce in the Chamber's efforts to convert the abandoned CNR Station into a Chamber headquarters building and information office. The committee received and filed a letter from Chamber Manager Ron Harris. Harris was asking for promotional material for the region that could be handed out, as well as financial assistance in the project. Committee members agreed the region shouldn't begin giving financial support to Chambers of Commerce.

No gifts to Halton employees

Suppliers or business associates won't be permitted to give Christmas gifts to employees of Halton Region. At least, that is a recommendation of Halton's Administration and Finance Committee which will meet today. The committee endorsed a report by Chief Administrative Officer Ernie Reid. In his report Reid said, "it would be against policy for any employee or his immediate family to accept from any company or representative of a company or person with whom we do or may do business, any gifts of value, including cash, merchandise, gift certificates, weekend or vacation trips. This means of course returning any such gifts which may be delivered to a home or office." Reid noted calendars and other nominal items wouldn't be considered to be in conflict with the policy.

Car skids road icy

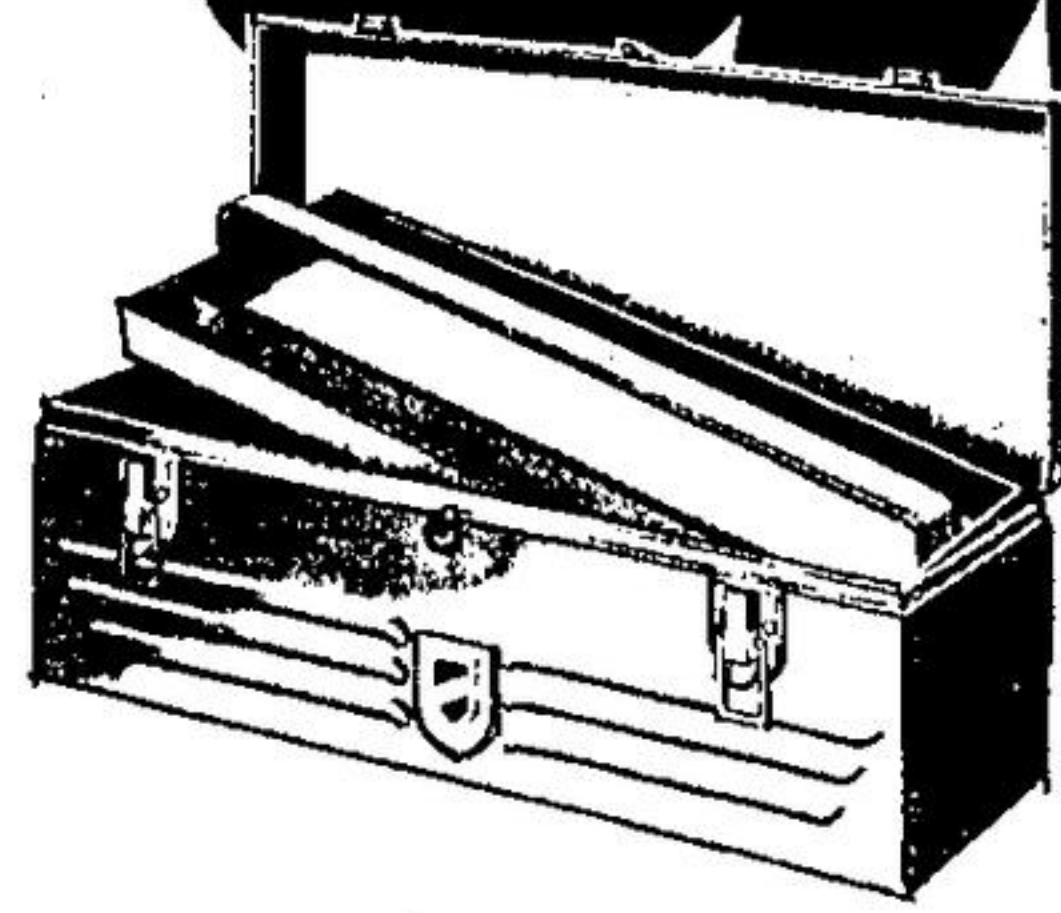
