Committee members agreed the region shouldn't begin giving financial support to Chambers of Commerce.

No gifts to Halton employees

Suppliers or business associates won't be permitted to give Christmas gifts to employees of Halton Region. At least, that is a recommendation Halton's Administration and Finance Committee will make to

council today. The committee endorsed a Administrative Officer Ernie Reid. In his report Reid said, "it would be against policy for any employee or his immediate family to accept from any company or representative of a company or person with whom we do or may do business, any gifts of value, including eash, merchandise, gift certificates, weekend or vacation trips. This means of course returning any such gifts which may be delivered to a home or office."

Reid noted calendars and other nominal items wouldn't be considered to be in conflict with the policy.
