## Teachers likely to be unionized

Tom Ramautarsingh, past president of the Halton district of the Secondary School Teachers Federation predicts sometime in the future teachers will be unionized. He was commenting on a call from Gordon Cressy, the new Toronto Board of Education Chairman, for teachers to unionize. Gordon Eagle, president of Halton district of the Ontario Public School Men Teachers' Federation, Peg Barton, president of the Halton district Federation of Women Teachers Association, and Keith Wallace, president of the Halton district of the Ontario Secondary School Teachers Federation, have all gone on record as being opposed to the idea of teachers forming a union. Ramautarsingh, who serves with a number of education groups in Ontario, said he has seen the move to unionization grow from year to year and it gains strength each year at the Teacher Federation's annual assemblies. "More and more people from business, industry, and commerce, are entering teaching. They are accustomed to being members of a union," he said as one explanation for the idea of a union's growth in recent years. He says some teachers think union procedures and practices can help the teachers fight for salaries, fringe benefits, and working conditions. Ramautarsingh added teachers are among the few people who don't negotiate for working conditions.
