

Scout and Guide Week across Canada begins this Sunday (February 16 to 23).

February 22 is the birthday of Lt. Gen. Lord Robert Stephenson Smythe Baden-Powell of Gilwell, founder of the Boy Scouts. The late Lord Baden-Powell was the Chief Scout of the world. His wife, Lady Baden Powell, who also celebrates her birthday on February 22 is Chief Guide of the world.

The purpose of the Boy Scouts of Canada is to help boys, youths, and young men develop their character as resourceful and responsible members of the community by providing opportunities and guidance for their mental, physical, social and spiritual development.

Camping trips, community services, earning badges, and meetings are all part

of the program to build our Boy Scouts into responsible adults.

The aim of the Girl Guides of Canada is to assist girls in character development by encouraging them to be responsible citizens of their country and of the world, by introducing them to adventure in the out-ofdoors, by training them in skills which will

help them to become good homemakers, and to experience the joy of giving service to others.

The girls learn to be responsible adults in today's society much in the same way the Scouls do. Camping trips, field trips, earning badges and community services play an important part in their development.
