Voice concern to Ont. cabinet

While it is not certain just what the thrust of the brief will be, Halton Region's Public Works Committee will be among those individuals and agencies making representation before the Ontario Cabinet March 12 when the Cabinet shifts its meeting to Hamilton Place in Hamilton.

The cabinet has been holding meetings around the province in different localities, advertising its meeting places and hearing briefs at each meeting.

The works committee agreed it should make representation. Changes in the election date for municipal elections, grants for sewage plants, earlier payment of grants and subsidies are among the issues considered.

Hill coming back

Ontario Federation of Agriculture President Gordon Hill will return to North Halton Feb. 27 to discuss land use policies currently being promoted by the OFA.

At press time a place for the meeting had not been determined. Mr. Hill spoke to a large number of Halton and Peel area farmers recently.

The OFA is promoting a policy that would preserve agricultural land and protect the agricultural industry from infringements of urban development.

Fear freeze

The controversial point among farmers is the proposed freeze of farm land. Some oppose any freeze at all while many are prepared to accept the freeze once an acceptable form of compensation is developed.

According to Halton Federation President, Harold Middlebrook, the OFA directors are slated to meet with the provincial cabinet Feb. 26. Middlebrook hopes new information on the situation will be available for the meeting of Feb. 27.

Value of goods up

Police have completed estimating the value of stolen goods recovered last week, and find the total increased from their original estimate to \$600. No charges have been laid as yet.

Increase in tank rentals

Inflation has hit the hot water tank rental business.

It was decided at last Thursday's hydro commission meeting to raise the rental costs of the 40-gallon tank to \$2 from \$1.75 and the 60-gallon tank to \$2.50 from \$2.25.

The cost of purchasing the tanks has gotten higher making it necessary for the hydro commission, to raise their prices.
