CVCA option
Erin property

The Credit Valley Conservation Authority has received an appraisal of \$40,000 on property owned by Floyd and Helen Zeigler situated south west of Erin village, abutting existing park land. Erin wishes to add the property, reached by access from Main and Church streets, to parkland and has requested assistance from the CVCA.

Authority project engineers submitted the appraisal recently and last Thursday's Authority meeting saw the motion carried that an option be taken to purchase the Zeigler property at a price of \$39,000.

Halton Region's Chief Administrative Officer Ernie Reid will probe the advantages and disadvantages of consolidating health and social services under one administrative unit in the region.

The initiative for the study comes from councillor Carl Eriksen.

"Instead of having separate and independent administrative units for social services, health and institutional facilities, does it not make sense to bring all these services under one common administrative unit? Would this not facilitate integrated delivery of such services? Would it not be simpler for the public to deal with only one department rather than several in obtaining the services needed? Would it not result in reduced administrative costs?" Eriksen asked.

The region's administration committee asked that the study be carried out and investigate the need for the possible changes in legislation that would bring together social services, health and institutions in the region.
