

**Policy on proclamations**

Two recent proclamations advertised and paid for by the town of Halton Hills, provoked a debate on policy at Halton Hills council Monday night.

Councillor Harry Levy raised the issue, saying he wanted to know if there was a policy.

Councillor Ern Hyde said "some of us made ourselves bloody unpopular when we voted against paying for a proclamation for Boy Scout week". He said the town should not pay for advertisements proclaiming certain weeks, unless it is town business.

Hyde said he wanted to know where the purchasing agent got the authority to advertise them. He said "if we don't do it for one, we shouldn't do it for any."

Councillor Ernie Sykes said a policy should be established if there isn't one, and said the finance committee should deal with it.

Councillor Pat McKenzie said the purchasing agent should not be criticized. "I am sure he was following policy not directing it."

Hyde replied he wasn't criticizing, but just wanted to know.

Councillor Ric Morrow said he understood the policy of proclaiming weeks, but not paying for any advertisements, had been established.

The administration will recommend a policy.

**More Ford layoffs**

Workers at the Ford plant, Oakville, will face their tenth layoff this year beginning June 9.

A plant spokesman announced recently the layoffs will affect 3,500 employees, many of whom live in Halton Hills.

About 3,100 workers will be eligible for the company's Supplementary Unemployment Benefits. The shut down in being blamed on high car inventories in the United States.

The plant has already had nine weeks of shut downs this year and after the employees return to the job they will work only two weeks before starting three weeks of vacations on July 7.

The riding contains, among others, the towns and villages of Arthur, Mount Forest, Elora, Erin, Hillsburgh, Grand Valley, Caledon, Bolton, Cataract, Belfountain, Orton and Fergus. The new riding can be classified as rural since it skirts most of the major population centres of the region.

Mr. Tynan feels quite certain that the election will be called for this fall, probably October.
