

### Sheep killed by loose dogs

Councillors from the Acton and Georgetown areas of Halton Hills, were made aware there is still a large rural area in the town when they were confronted with claims for killed and injured sheep last week.

One sheep was killed and another injured by dogs running at large on Bud Bishop's farm on the Ninth Line. On the A Franchino land on the Sixth Line, one sheep was killed, another injured and three chicks killed, also by dogs.

Under the Livestock Protection Act Mr. Bishop was reimbursed \$50, and Mr. Franchino \$22.

The awards are made after inspection by Livestock Evaluator Clare Wilson.

### Terra Cotta improvements

Grants in the amount of \$99,750 have been approved by the Ministry of Natural Resources to carry out extensive improvements to the Terra Cotta Conservation Area in Halton Hills, Halton East MPP and Minister of Government Services Jim Snow announced this week.

The Credit Valley Conservation Authority expects to spend an estimated \$109,500 on further capital work which will include completion of the modified swimming pool, grounds improvement, bountary fencing, service.

### New licence outlet

A check with Acton retailers produced no interest, so the finance committee of Halton Hills council decided to recommend Georgetown retailer Pete Pomeroy be authorized to sell bicycle licences at his North Halton Sports.

"If other retailers show interest they can be added as we go along," said Ward One Councillor Pat McKenzie.

The committee agreed, recommending other outlets for bicycle licences be explored. They are presently for sale at municipal offices, Georgetown, and at the police office in Acton.

A two-weekend rummage sale has put about \$500 into the building fund for a new residence for retarded adults at Hornby. North Halton Association for the Mentally Retarded held the sale Saturdays June 14 and 21 at ARC workshop, Hornby.

ARC manager Mrs. W. Isham said the first day's rummage sale was a big success so the sponsors decided to hold it again last Saturday. The second day wasn't as well attended.
