Staff keeps presses rolling



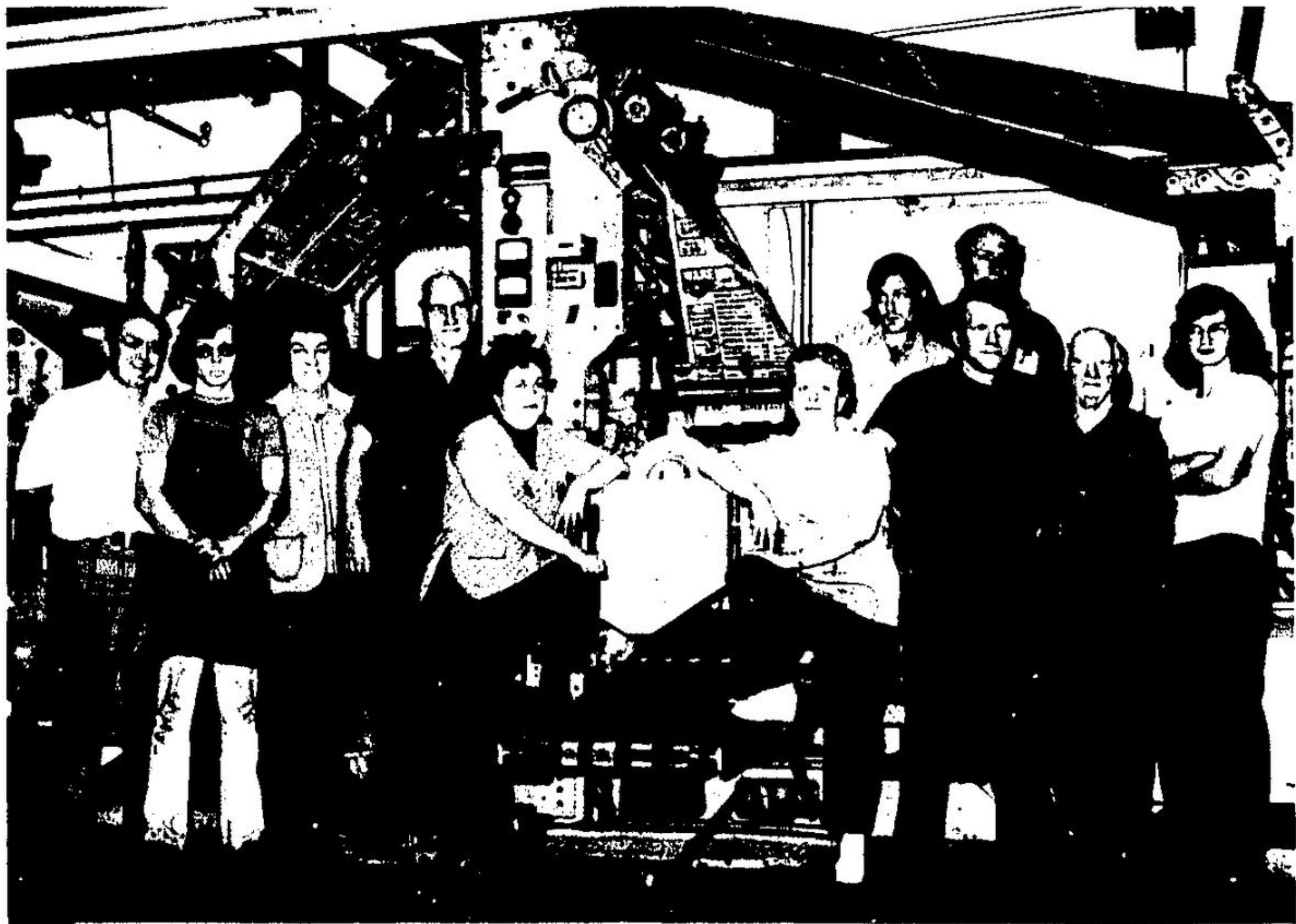
