"Halton Hills appears to be lucky because it is a fairly wealthy community and this can help discourage growth. If a town has money and can keep taxes down the battle against growth is a lot easier. When people start wanting Toronto level services, like new arenas, but still want low proposed industrial park taxes councils are very tempted to allow growth so they can increase revenues," the budding planners ex-

They observed that there is a high standard of planning in Georgetown but not much planning has been done in Acton or Esquesing.

"There is a much longer history of planning in Georgetown and the standards are high. Acton hasn't done very much planning and not very many background studies have been done there. Planning in the rural areas have also been rather limited.

Wood noted rural planning is something new and people are going to have to get used to it. He pointed out that they have been talking to farmers


