TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Eramosa intends to apply to The Ontario Municipal Board pursuant to the provisions of Section 30 of The Planning Act for approval of By-Law No. 12-1975 passed on the 28th day of July, 1975. A copy of the by-law is furnished herewith.

ANY PERSON INTERESTED MAY, within fourteen (14) days after the date of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the clerk of the Township of Eramosa notice of his objection to approval of the said by-law, together with a statement of the grounds of such objection.

ANY PERSON wishing to support the application for approval of the by-law may within fourteen (14) days after the date of this notice send by registered mail or deliver to the clerk of the Township of Eramosa notice of his support of approval of the said by-law together with a request for notice of any hearing that may be held giving also the name and address to which such notice should be given.

THE ONTARIO MUNICIPAL BOARD may approve of the said by-law but before doing so it may appoint a time and place when any objection to the by-law will be considered. Notice of any hearing that may be held will be given only to persons who have filed an objection or notice of support and who have left with or delivered to the clerk undersigned, the address to which notice of hearing is to be sent.

THE LAST DATE FOR FILING OBJECTIONS WILL BE September 19, 1975, DATED at the Township of Eramosa this 27th day of August, 1975.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

BY-LAW NO. 12-1975

The purpose of this by-law is to change the zoning from Residential to Agricultural on certain lands in the Police Village of Rockwood lying north-east of Queen Street and south-west of the Village limits.

The lands were originally zoned Residential in anticipation of municipal piped sewage disposal facilities being installed in Rockwood. However, since the installation of such services is not now anticipated in the immediate future, intensive residential development of the lands subject of this by-law is deemed to be premature.

The effect of this by-law is to permit the subject lands to be used only for those uses now permitted in an Agricultural Zone 'A' of By-Law 25-68 of the Township of Eramosa. Copies of By-Law 25-68 are available for inspection in the Township Clerk's office during normal business hours.
